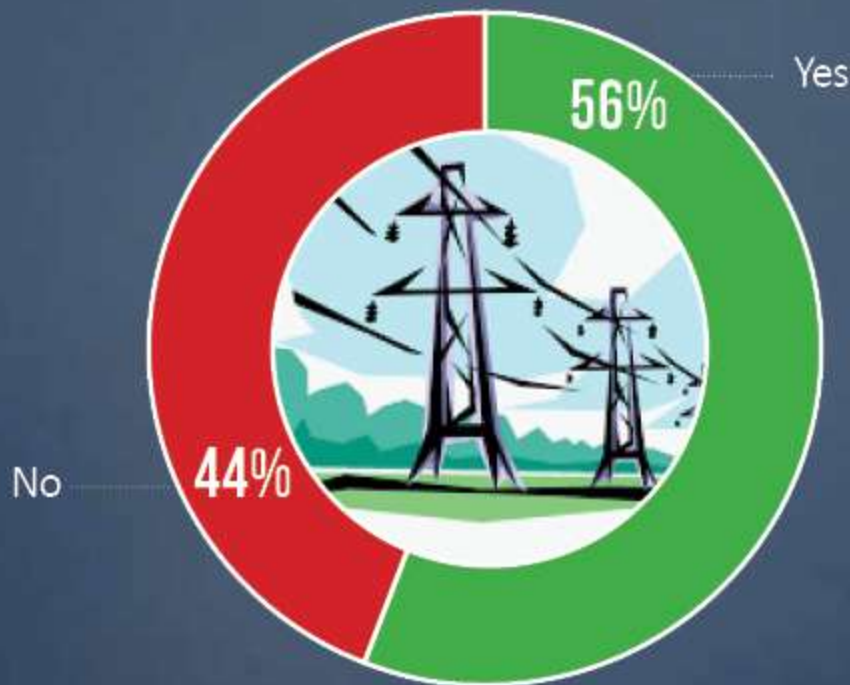

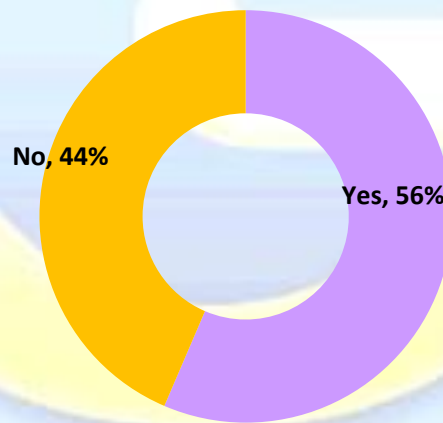
More than half (56%) of respondents from flood affected areas say that the recent flooding disrupted electricity supply: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

A representative sample of adult men and women from the flood borne areas was asked the following question: *“Has the supply of electricity disrupted due to the floods?”* 56% said ‘Yes’ and 44% said ‘No’

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 254 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, from September 01, 2022 – September 16, 2022. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 3 -5 percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic and Face to Face surveys
