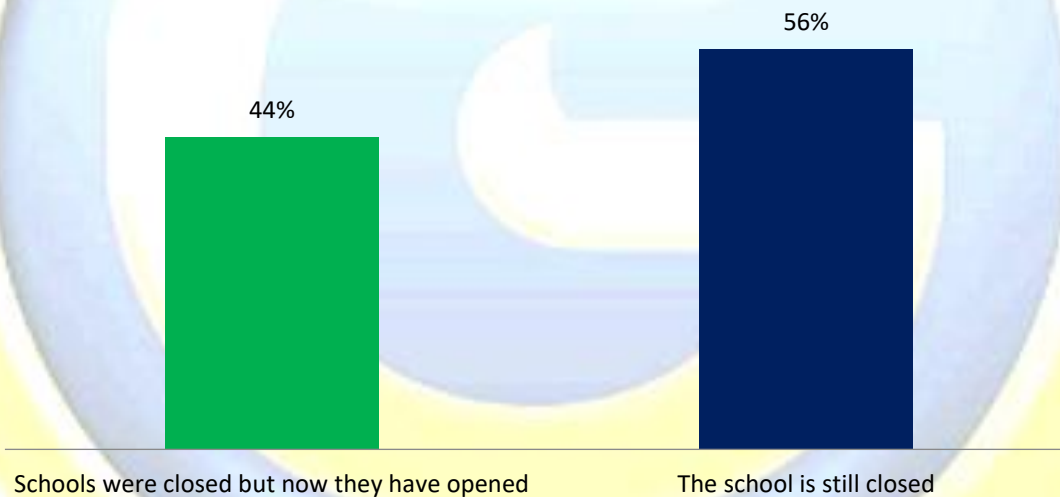
56% of respondents from flood affected areas say schools continue to be closed because of the floods: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 56% of respondents say schools continue to be closed because of the floods

A representative sample of adult men and women from the flood borne areas was asked the following question:, “Are schools closed in your area due to the floods?” 56% said that the schools are still closed whereas 44% responded that the schools were closed but now they have opened again.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 254 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, from September 01, 2022 – September 16, 2022. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 3-5$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic and Face to Face surveys
