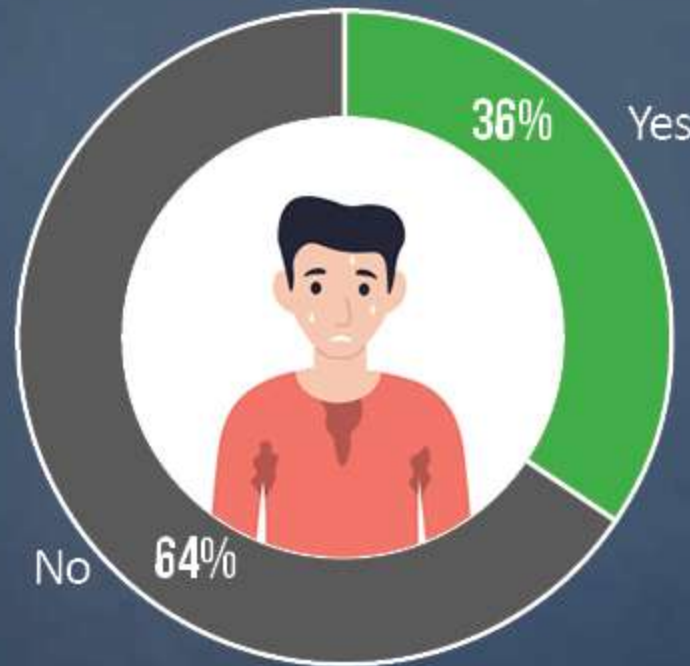

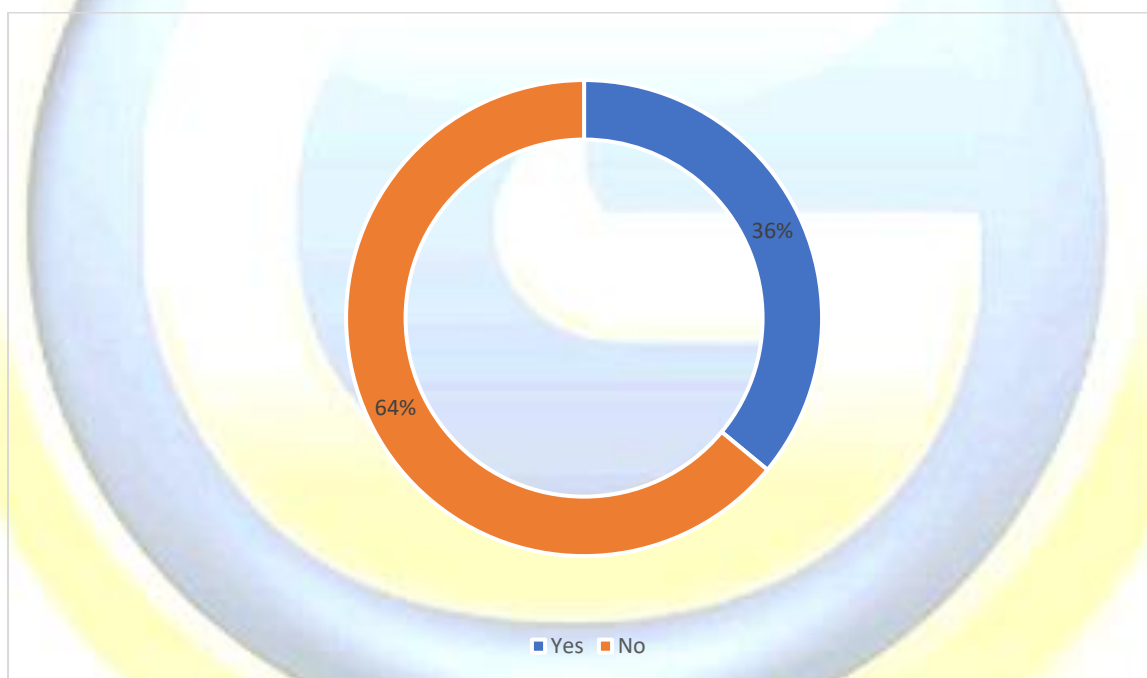
Less than half of Pakistani's (36%) take part in any work at least once a week that causes them heavy sweating: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), November 2nd, 2022

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, less than half of Pakistani's (36%) take part in any work at least once a week that causes them heavy sweating.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the following question regarding, "Did you do any work at least once a week that caused you heavy sweating, or made you beat very fast?" 36% said yes while 64% responded no.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 500 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
