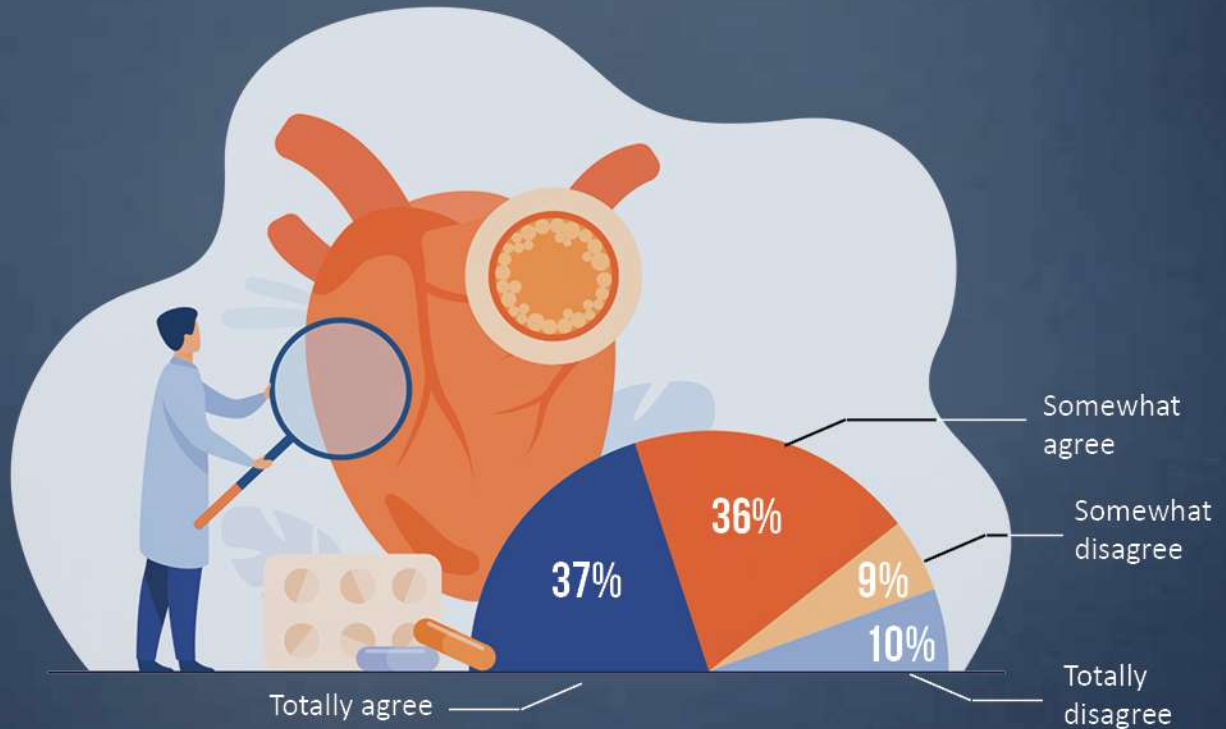

73% PAKISTANIS AS COMPARED TO 28% BRITONS AGREE THAT EVENTUALLY ALL MEDICAL CONDITIONS AND DISEASES WILL BE CURABLE: GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN

73% Pakistanis as compared to 28% Britons agree that eventually all medical conditions and diseases will be curable: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

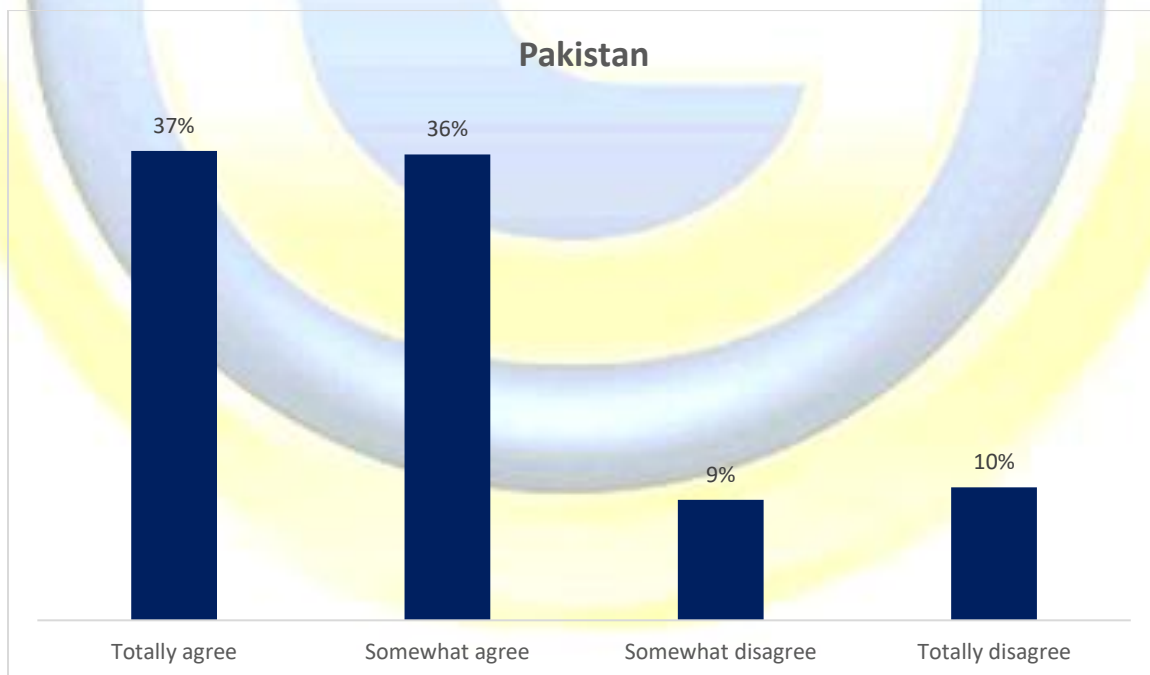

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 73% Pakistanis as compared to 28% British people agree that eventually all medical conditions and diseases will be curable.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the following question regarding, *“To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statements? - Eventually all medical conditions and diseases will be curable?”* 37% totally agreed with the statement, 36% said that they somewhat agree, 9% responded that they somewhat disagreed while 10% totally disagreed with the statement.

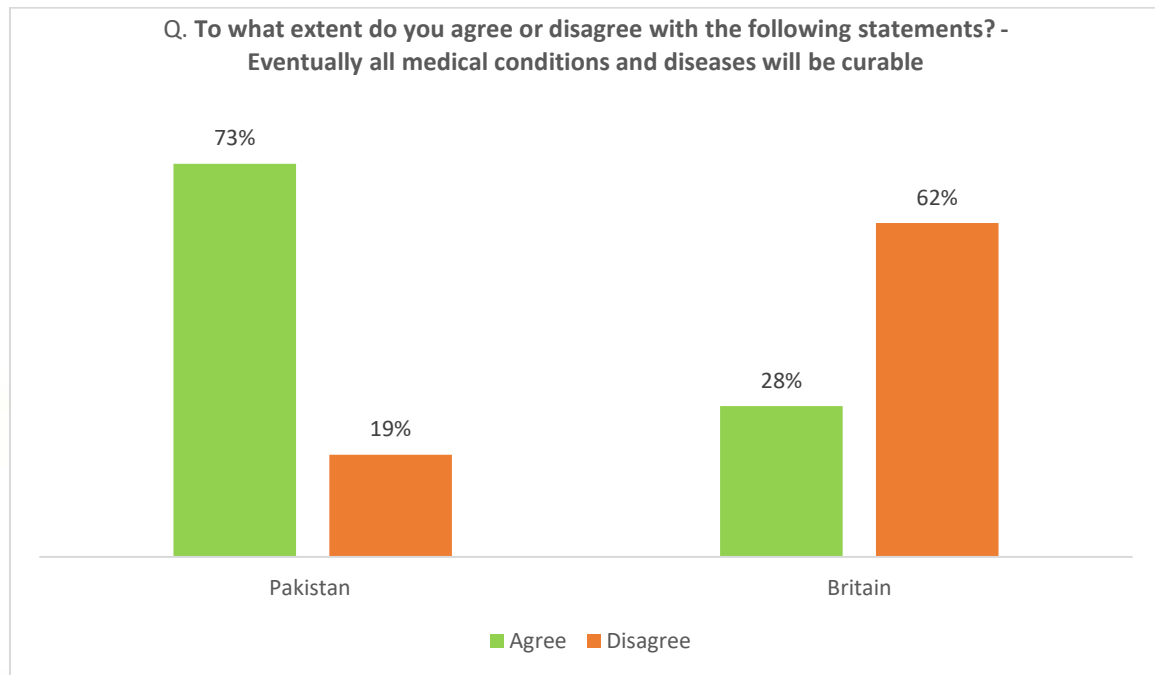
Comparison between Pakistan and Britain: The same question was asked in Britain by [IPSOS](#) (the study can be found [here](#)) and in response, 28% said that they agree with the statement while 62% said that they disagree that eventually all medical conditions and diseases will be curable. When compared with Britain, people in Pakistan seem to be more optimistic that all medical conditions and diseases will be curable.

Comparison with Britain: The following question was asked in Britain and in Pakistan: “To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statements? - Eventually all medical conditions and diseases will be curable” In response, 73% Pakistanis said that they agree with the statement while 19% said that they disagree. On the other hand, 28% Britons agreed while 62% of them disagreed with the statement.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1107 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI) and the data collection was done during 16 Nov – 28 Nov 2022.
