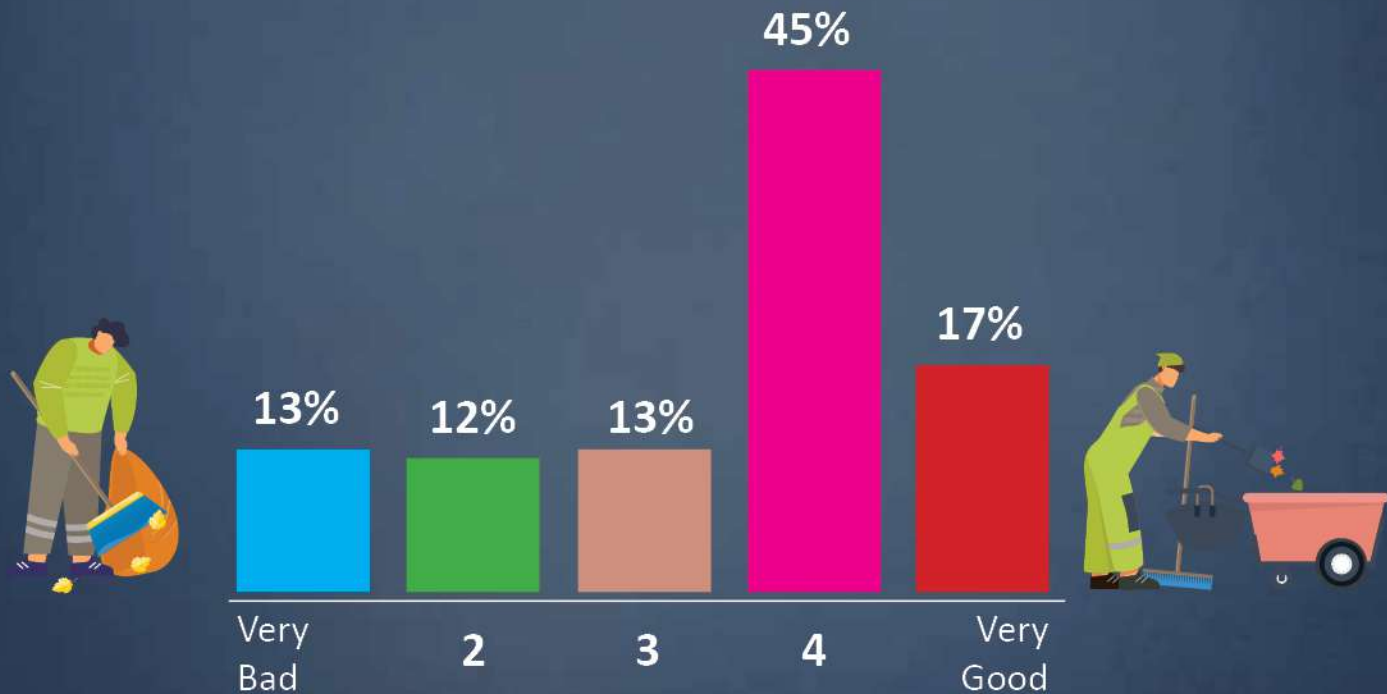

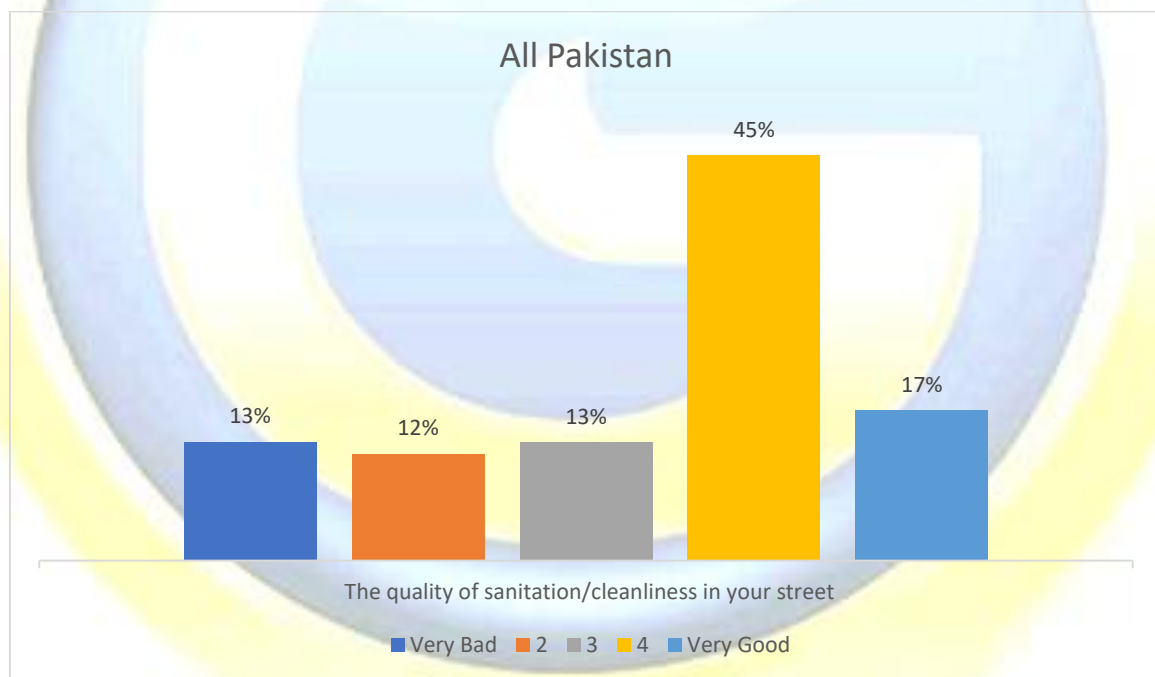
3 in 5 (62%) Pakistanis think that the quality of sanitation/cleanliness in their street is good: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), January 18th, 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 3 in 5 (62%) Pakistanis think that the quality of sanitation/cleanliness in their street is good.

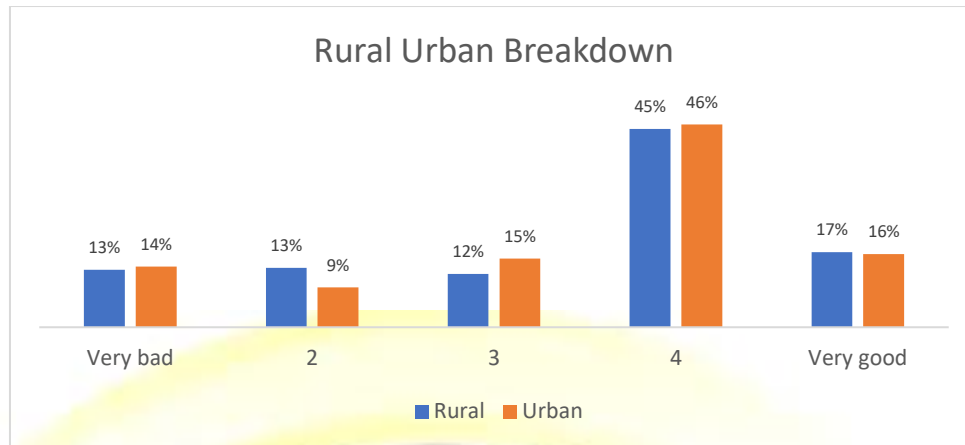
A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the following question regarding, “On a scale of 1 to 5, where 1 is “very bad” and 5 is “very good”, how would you rank each of the following services?- The quality of sanitation/cleanliness in your street” 13% said it is very bad, 12% said it is bad, 13% said the air quality of sanitation/cleanliness in their street is average, 45% said that this it is good while 17% said that it is very good.

Question: “On a scale of 1 to 5, where 1 is “very bad” and 5 is “very good”, how would you rank each of the following services? – The quality of sanitation/cleanliness in your street”



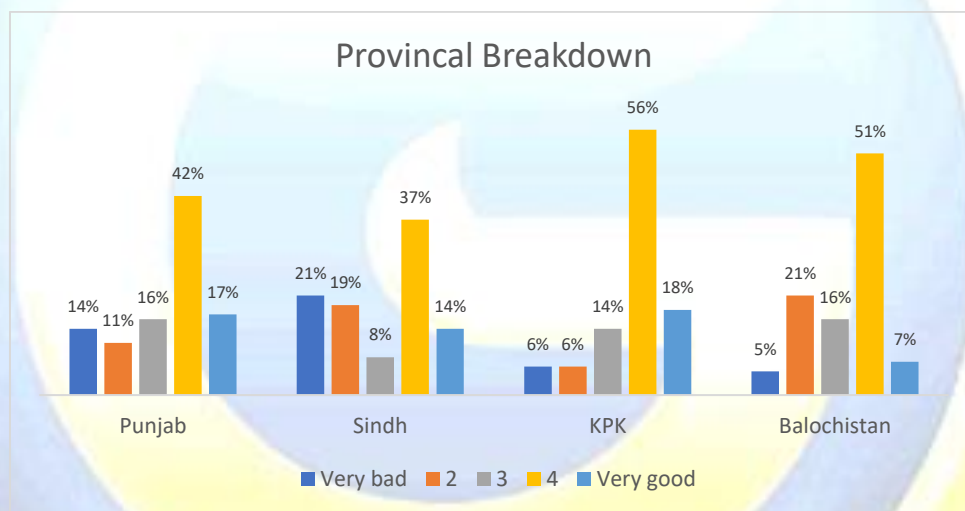

When the rural-urban breakdown for the responses is analyzed, it can be seen the same percentage of people from urban and rural areas say that the quality of sanitation/cleanliness in their street is good/very good as 62% from rural and urban areas reported that.

Analysis of the provincial breakdown shows that the highest proportion of people who that the quality of cleanliness/sanitation in their street is good/very good belongs to KPK as 74% said so, second was Punjab as 59% said their street had good/very good cleanliness/sanitation, then came Balochistan with 58% saying the same while the least number of people who said that the cleanliness/sanitation in their street is good/very good was from Sindh as 51% said so.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 747 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI)
