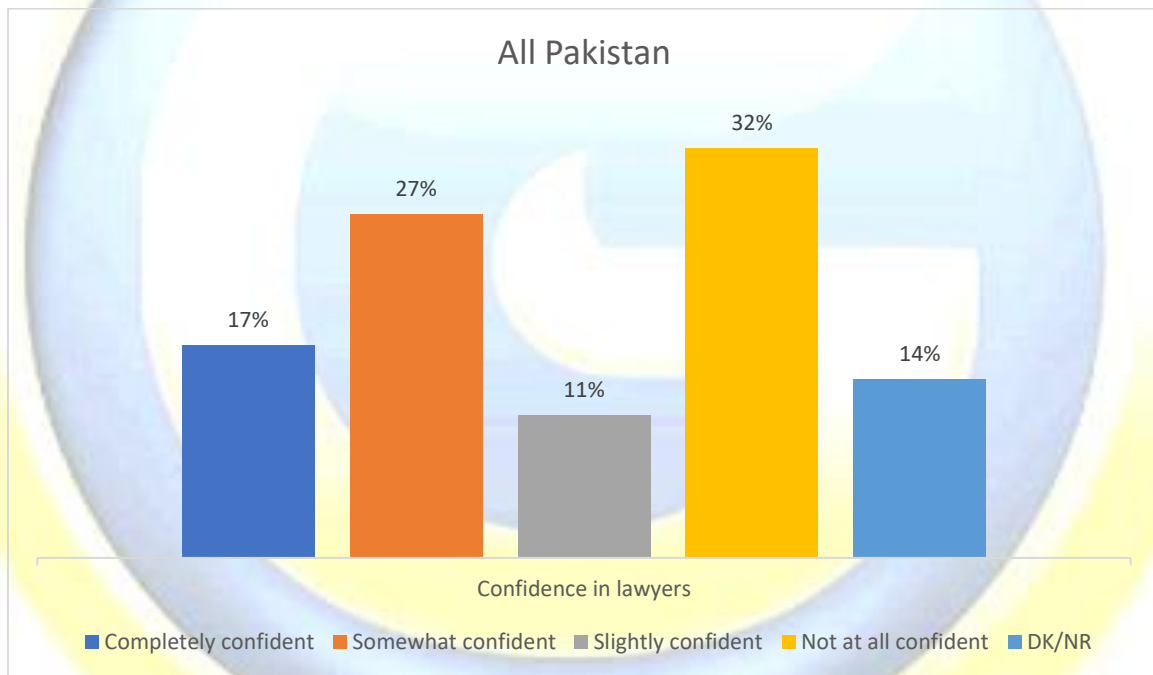
32% Pakistanis do not have any level of confidence in lawyers: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), January 25th, 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, more than half of Pakistanis (55%) have at least some level of confidence in lawyers

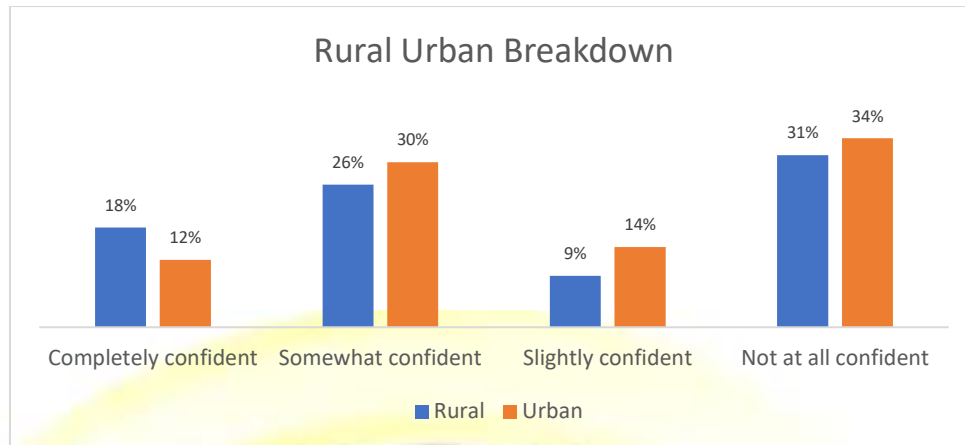
A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the following question regarding, *“Please indicate how confident you are in the following: - In lawyers?”* 17% said they’re completely confident, 27% said they are somewhat confident, 11% reported slight confidence while 32% said they are not at all confident in lawyers whereas 14% did not respond or said that they did not know.

Question: “Please indicate how confident you are in the following: -In lawyers”



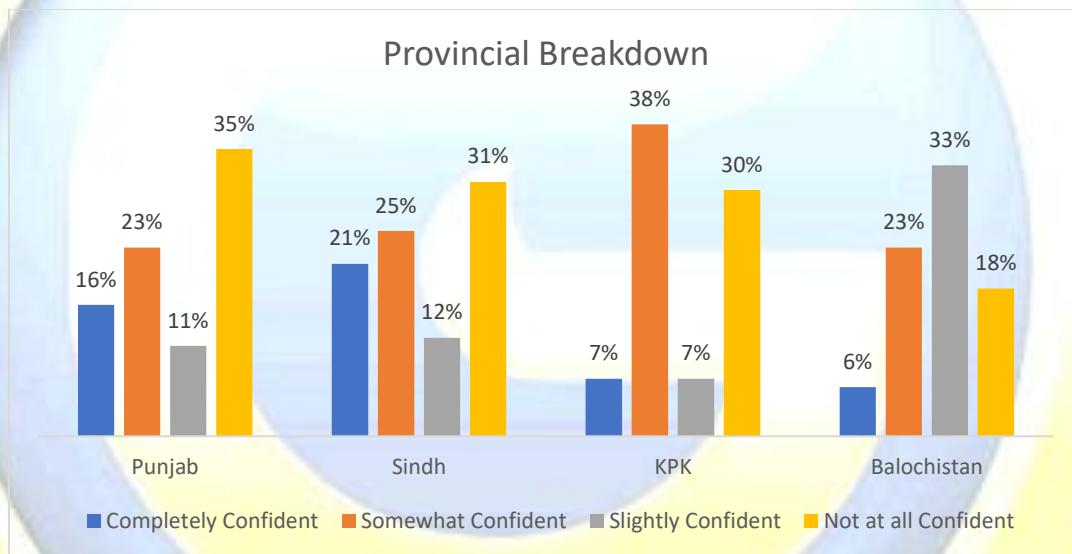

When the rural-urban breakdown for the responses is analyzed, it can be seen that 3% more people from urban areas are not at all confident in lawyers than rural areas as 34% from rural and 31% from urban areas reported having no confidence in lawyers.

Analysis of the provincial breakdown shows that the highest percentage of people who have no confidence in lawyers was from Punjab as 35% reported that, followed by Sindh with 31% saying they had no confidence in lawyers, which was followed by KPK with 30% saying so. The least number of people who reported having no confidence in lawyers was from Balochistan as 18% said so.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 747 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI)
