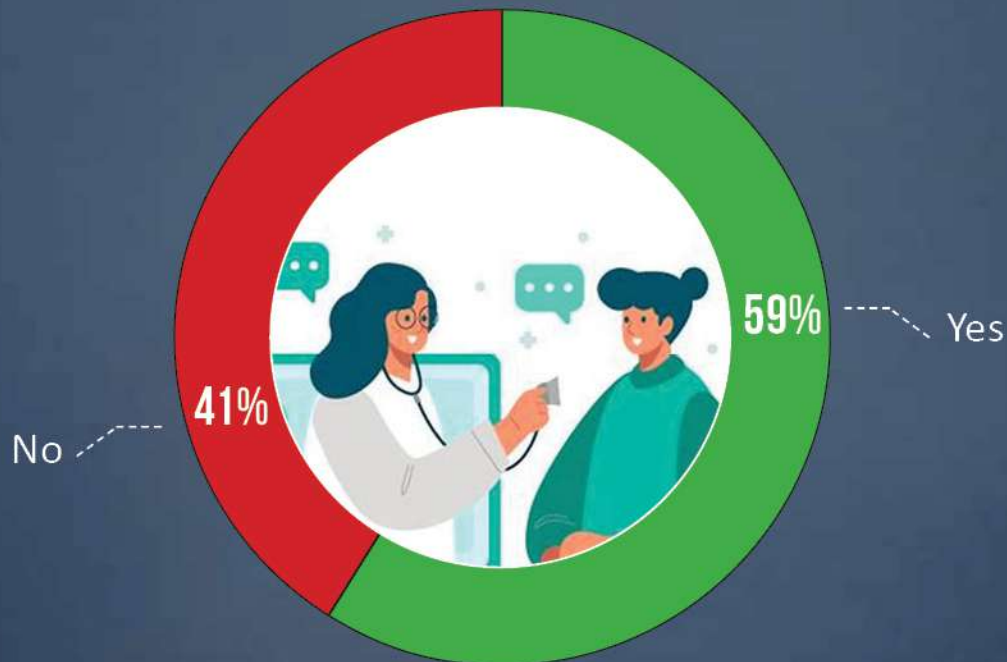

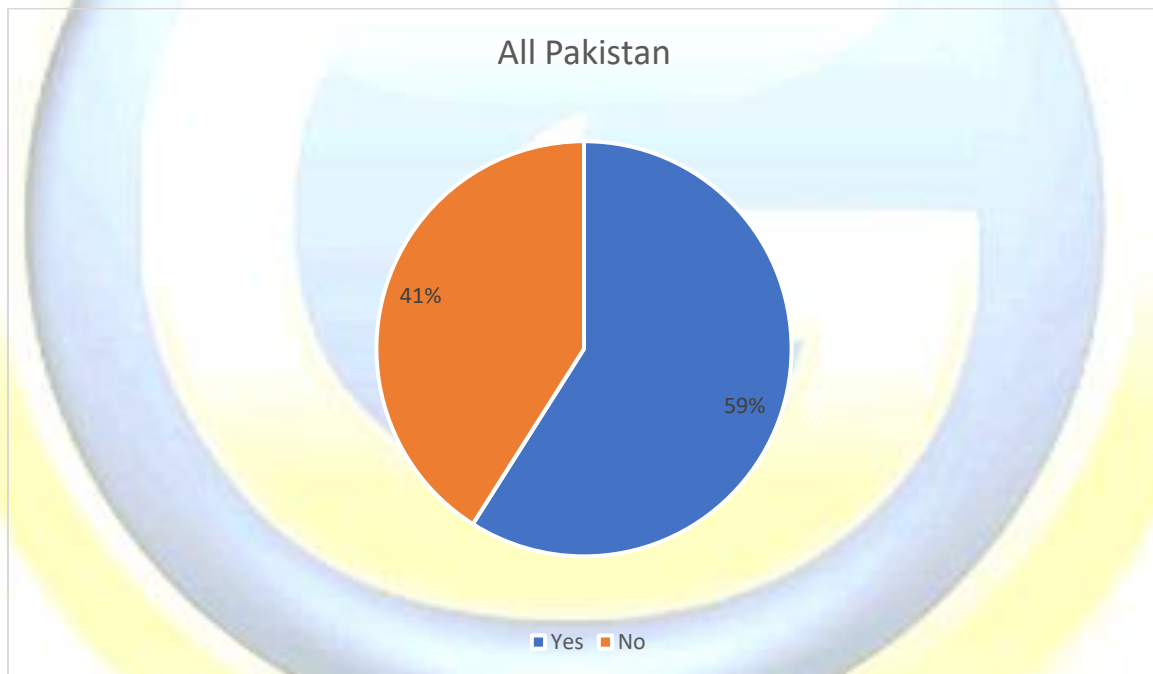
3 in 5 Pakistanis report seeing a doctor in the last 12 months: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), January 26th, 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 3 in 5 Pakistanis report seeing a doctor in the last 12 months

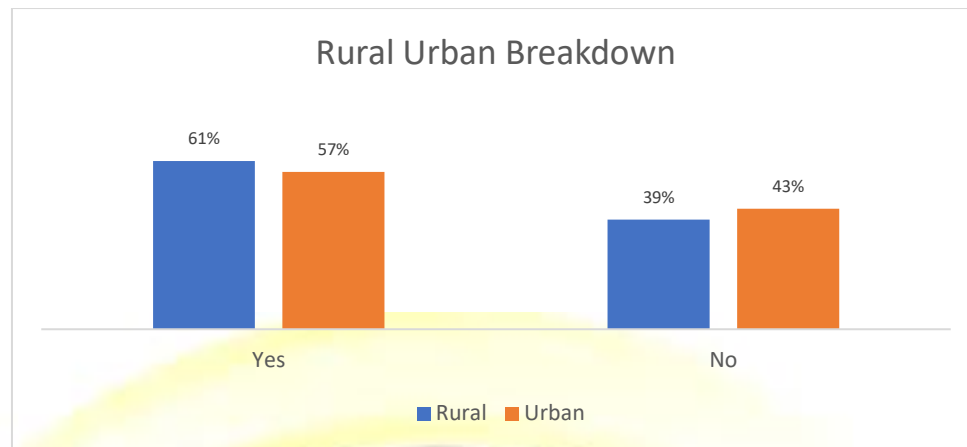
A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the following question regarding, “Have you seen a doctor in the last 12 months?” 59% said yes while 41% responded no.

Question: “Have you seen a doctor in the last 12 months?”



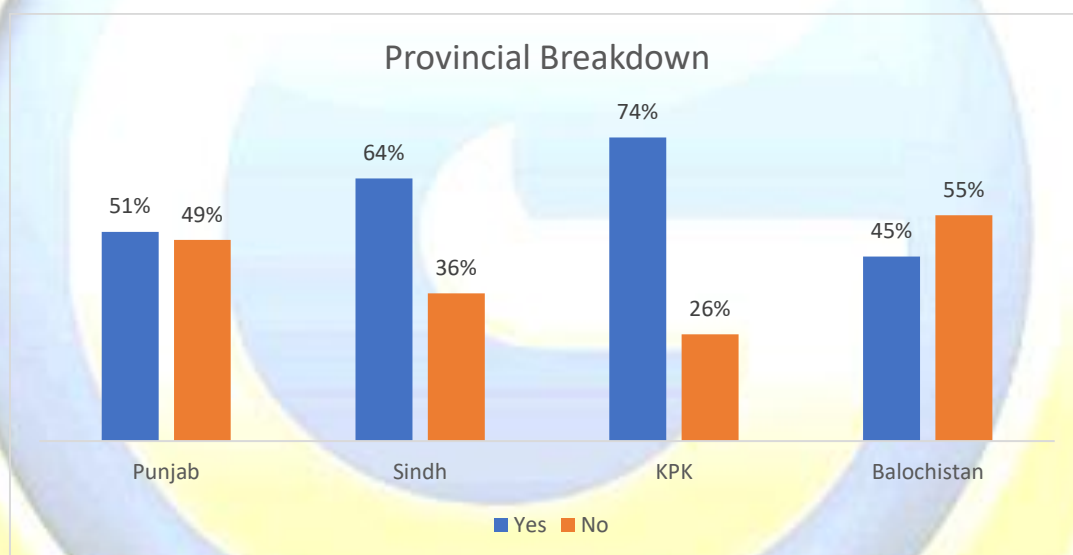

When the rural-urban breakdown for the responses is analyzed, it can be seen that 4% more people from rural areas report seeing a doctor in the last 12 months as 61% said so as compared to 57% from urban areas.

Analysis of the provincial breakdown shows that the highest percentage of people who saw a doctor in the last 12 months belong to KPK as 74% said that they visited a doctor, followed by Sindh where 64% said they went to the doctor, this was followed by Punjab as 51% reported the same. The least number of people who reported visiting the doctor in the last few months belongs to Balochistan as 45% said answered 'yes' to the question.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 747 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI)
