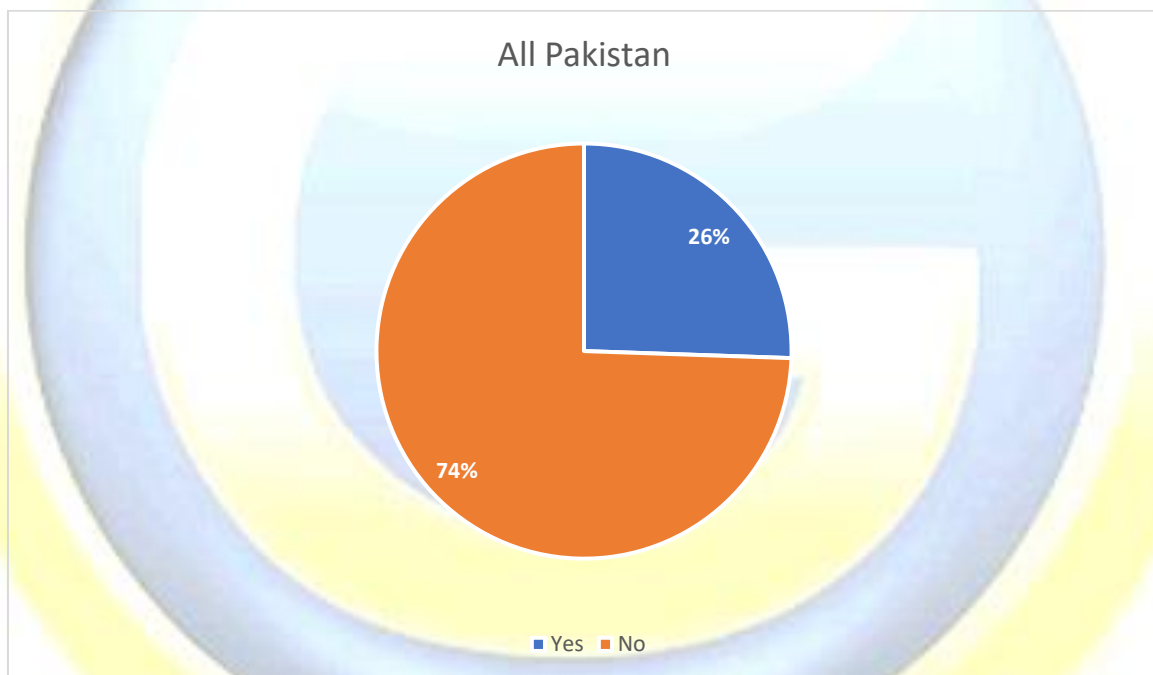
74% of the respondents who had a family member admitted in the hospital last year said that they did not get any referral or help for hospitalization: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 74% of the respondents who had a family member admitted in the hospital last year said that they did not get any referral or help for hospitalization.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country, who responded yes to the question “*Has anyone in your family had to be admitted to the hospital in the last year?*” was asked the following as a follow up question, “*Did you have to get any referrals or help etc for hospitalization?*” 26% responded yes while 74% said no.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 747 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI)
