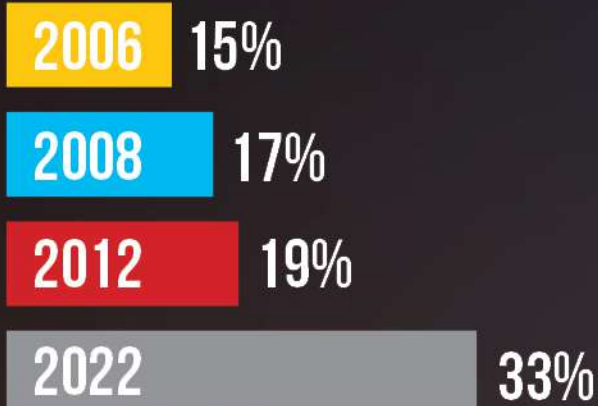

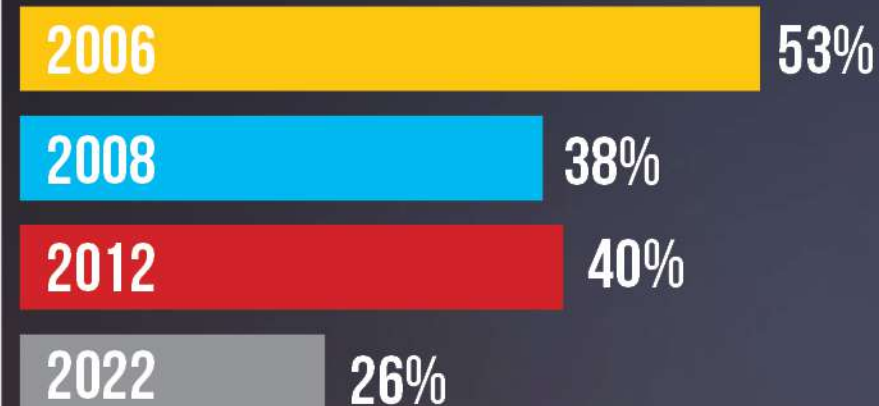

Question: "Do you think that expert doctors are available only in Government Hospitals or only in Private hospitals or both?"

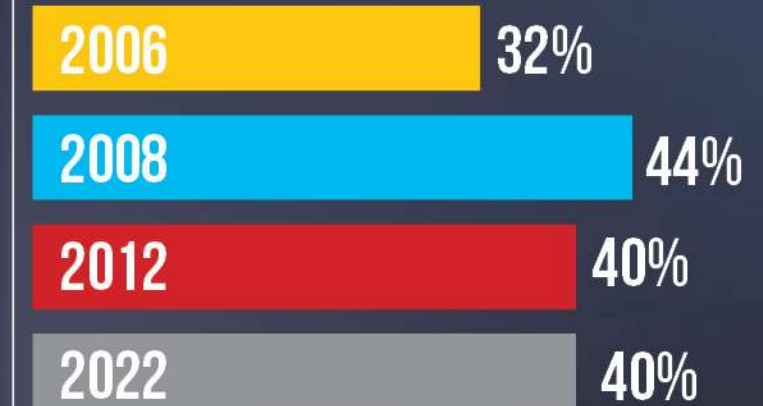
Government Hospital

From 2006 to 2022, there has been an 18% increase in the people who believe that expert doctors are available at government hospitals: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan History Project

(Islamabad), March 02nd, 2023

In a Gallup & Gilani Pakistan National Survey conducted in the year 2006, a representative sample of adult men and women from across Pakistan was asked the following question, “Do you think that expert doctors are available only in Government Hospitals or only in Private hospitals or both?” In response to this question, 15% said government hospital, 53% said private hospital while 32% said both.

Comparative Picture: This question was asked again in 2022 to allow a comparison to be made across the years. In 2022, 33% said that expert doctors are available at government hospitals, 26% said they are available at private hospitals while 40% responded that they believe both, government and private hospitals have expert doctors available.

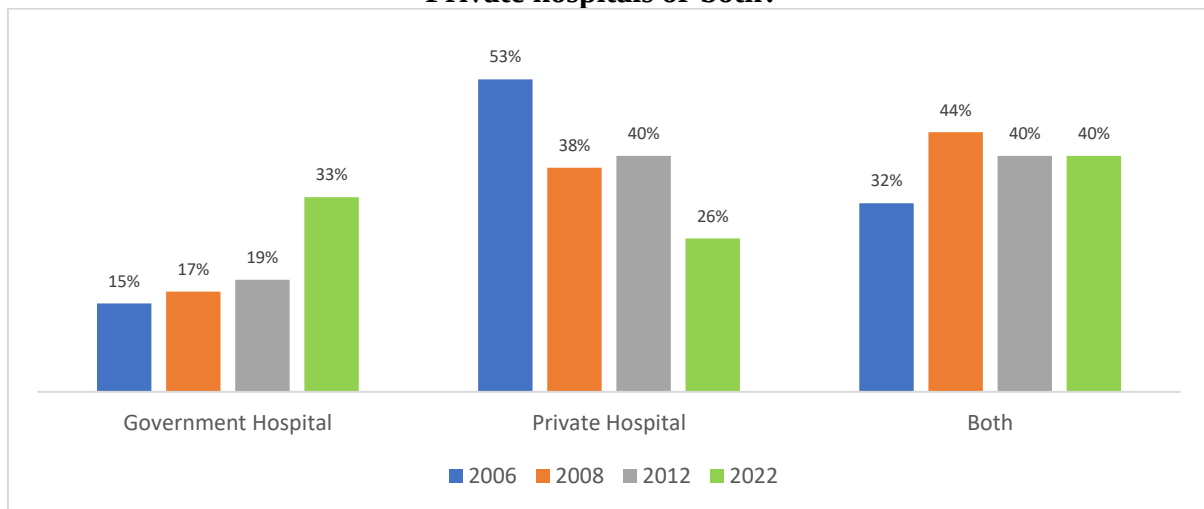
Trend Analysis: From 2006 to 2022, there has been an 18% increase in the proportion of people who think that expert doctors are available at government hospitals while the number of people who believe that expert doctors are available at private hospitals have declined by 27%. Over the 16 years, there has been an increase of 8% who think that expert doctors are available at both kinds of hospitals.

Bilal I Gilani Executive Director Gallup Pakistan adds:

“The findings of this poll and in fact series of polls which makes up this trend series, shows increased people trust in government sector hospitals. This is a consistent trend we are seeing and is perhaps an endorsement of increased government interest in health care seen in past 2 decades with new and large-scale tertiary care and specialized hospitals being set up. The likes of NICVD and their expansion in Sindh and PKLI as well as expansion of MCH hospitals in Punjab as well as massive boost in KP through Sehat Insaaf cards may be at the core of this acknowledgement by the wider public.”

This press release has been made as part of the Gallup Pakistan History Project which aims to release historical empirical polling data to wider audiences. The objective is to sustain and encourage empirical decision-making in Pakistan.
