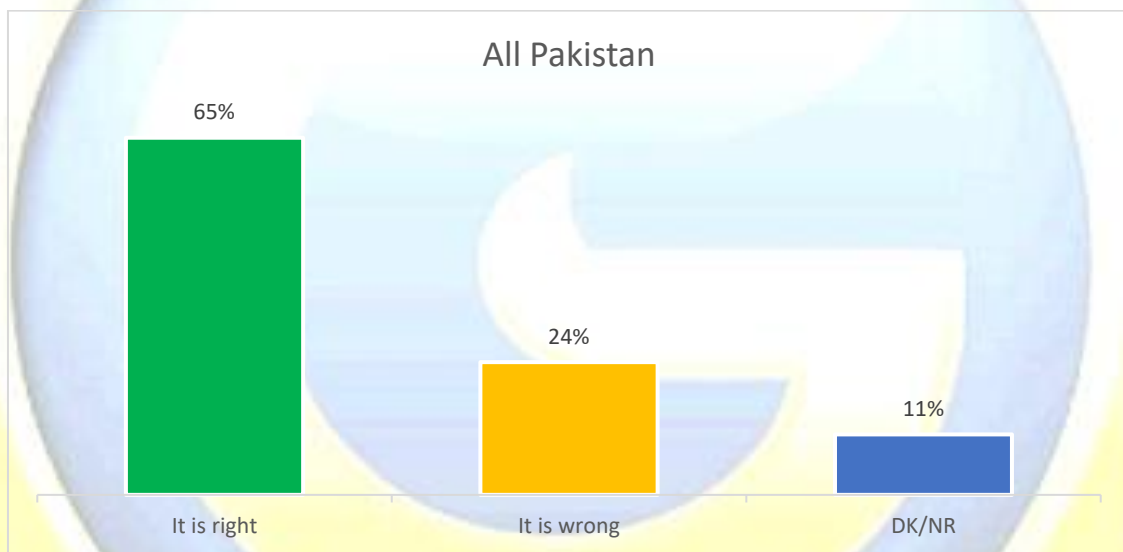
65% Pakistanis think that it is right to donate eyes to deserving people in your life: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), March 14th, 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 65% Pakistanis think that it is right to donate eyes to deserving people in your life.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country, who responded yes to the question “Some people think that it is a good thing to donate your eyes to deserving people in your life, while others are not in favor of it. What is your opinion about it?” In response, 65% said it is right while 24% said that it is wrong.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 764 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI)
