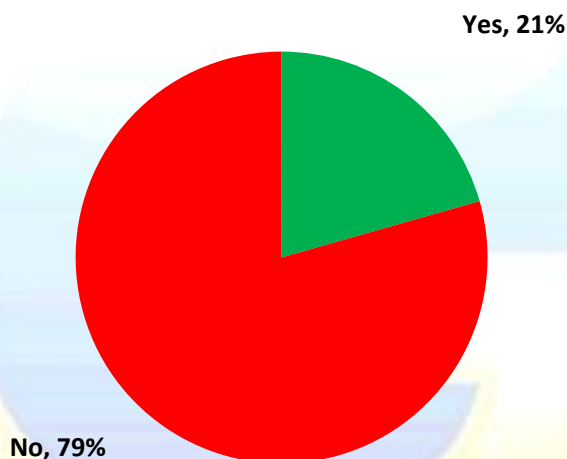
1 in 5 (21%) Pakistanis report that someone in their household lost their job in the last six months: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 1 in 5 (21%) Pakistanis report that someone in their household lost their job in the last six months.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country, who responded yes to the question “Is there someone in your household who lost his / her job in the past six months?” In response, 21% said yes while 79% responded no.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1760 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was Face to Face Survey Using Stratified Random Sampling with Census 2017 as the frame and Census Blocks as Primary Sampling Units.
