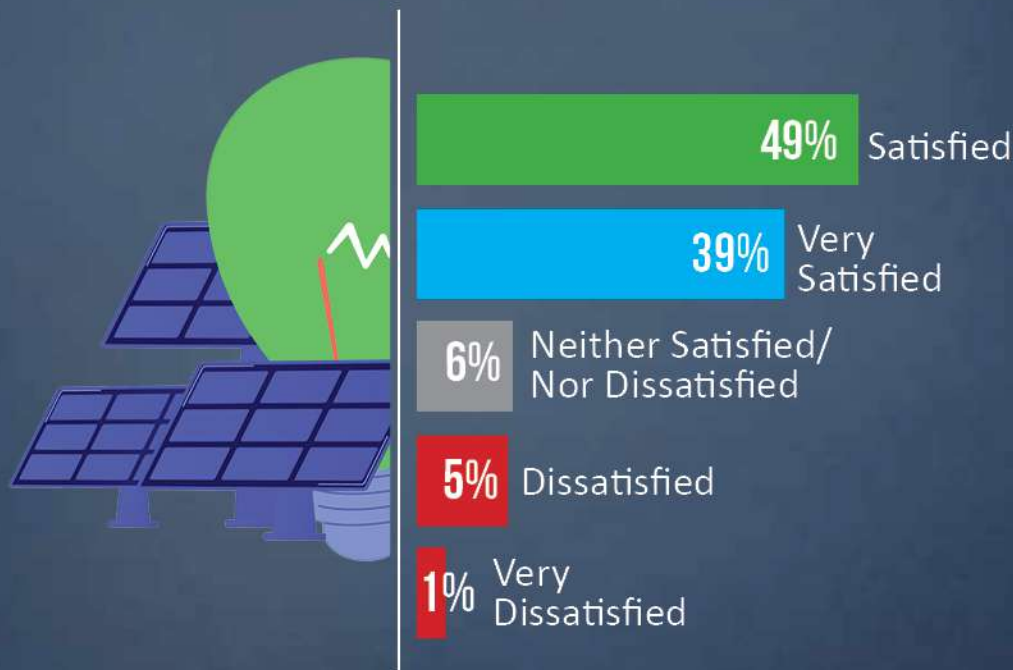

88% of solar panel users having net metering at their home are satisfied/very satisfied with the overall performance of the solar panels installed in their homes: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

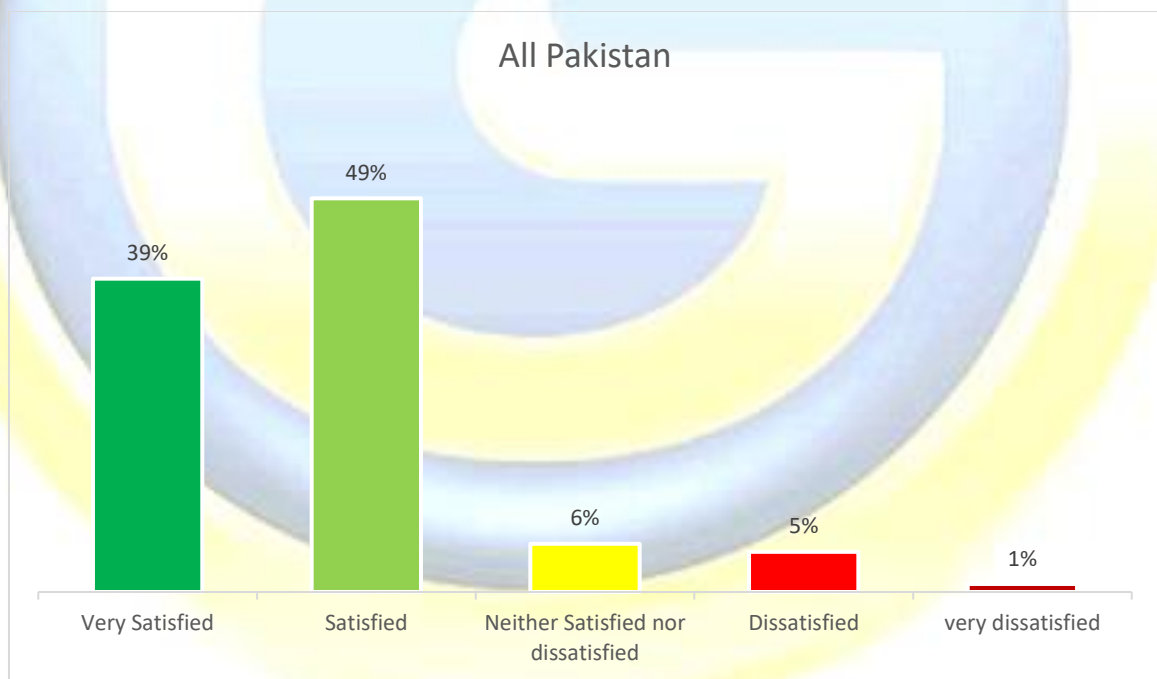

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 88% of solar panel users having net metering at their home are satisfied/very satisfied with the overall performance of the solar panels installed in their homes.

A representative sample of net-metered individuals from across the country, was asked the question “How satisfied/dissatisfied are you with the overall performance of the solar panels installed?” In response, 39% said they were very satisfied, 49% said they were satisfied, 6% reported neither satisfaction nor dissatisfaction, while 5% said they were dissatisfied and 1% said they were very dissatisfied.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 152 men and women, Gallup compiled a directory of net-metering users based on net-metering licenses. This data is available on NEPRA’s website where net-metering licenses as issued to users are

available. A WhatsApp message was drafted to circulate among the users identified via NEPRA's website. The method of data collection included a self-filled survey on WhatsApp.
