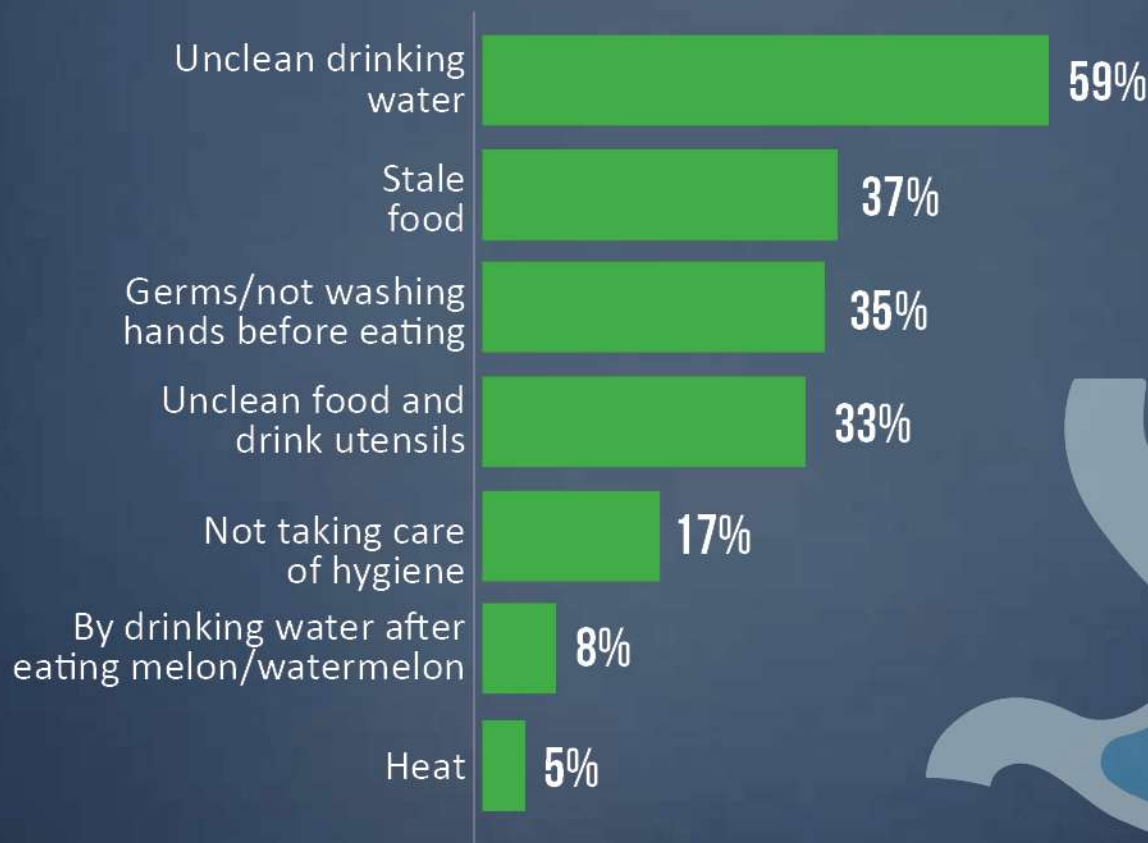

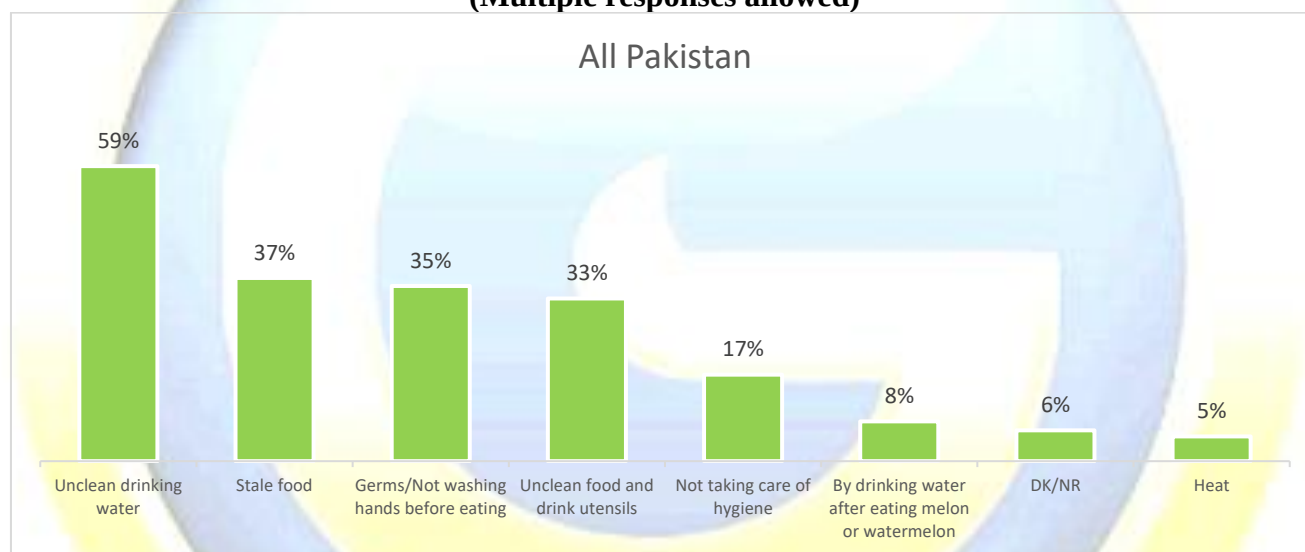
59% Pakistanis say that unclean drinking water is the main cause of diarrhea/cholera: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), April 05th, 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 59% Pakistanis say that unclean drinking water is the main cause of diarrhea/cholera.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country, was asked the question “What do you think are the causes of diarrhea/cholera?” In response, 59% said unclean drinking water, 37% said stale food, 35% responded germs/not washing hands before eating, 33% said unclean food and drink utensils, 17% responded not taking care of hygiene, 8% said by drinking water after eating melon/watermelon, 5% said heat while 6% did not respond or said the did not know.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 764 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI)
