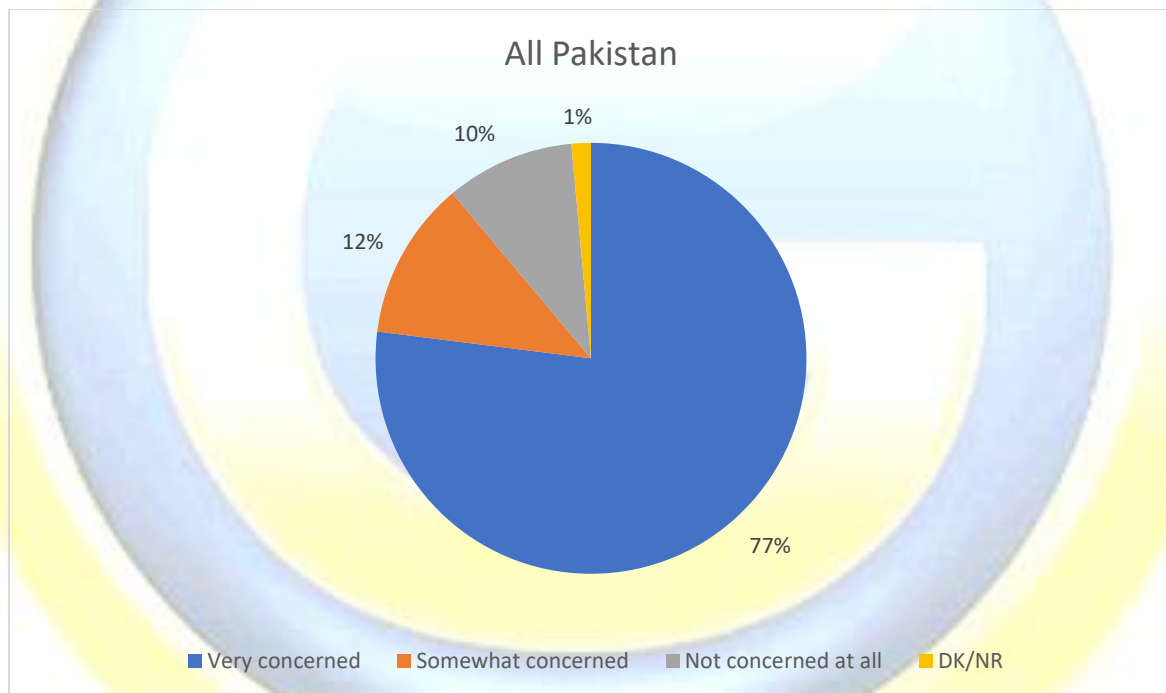
An overwhelming majority of Pakistanis (89%) are concerned about the gap between the rich and the poor: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), May 08th, 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, a huge majority of Pakistanis (89%) are concerned about the gap between the rich and the poor.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country, was asked the question “Please tell us how concerned you are about the gap between the rich and the poor?” In response, 77% said they were very concerned, 12% said they were somewhat concerned, 10% said they were not at all concerned and 1% did not respond or said they did not know.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1135 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 14 to 22 March 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI)
