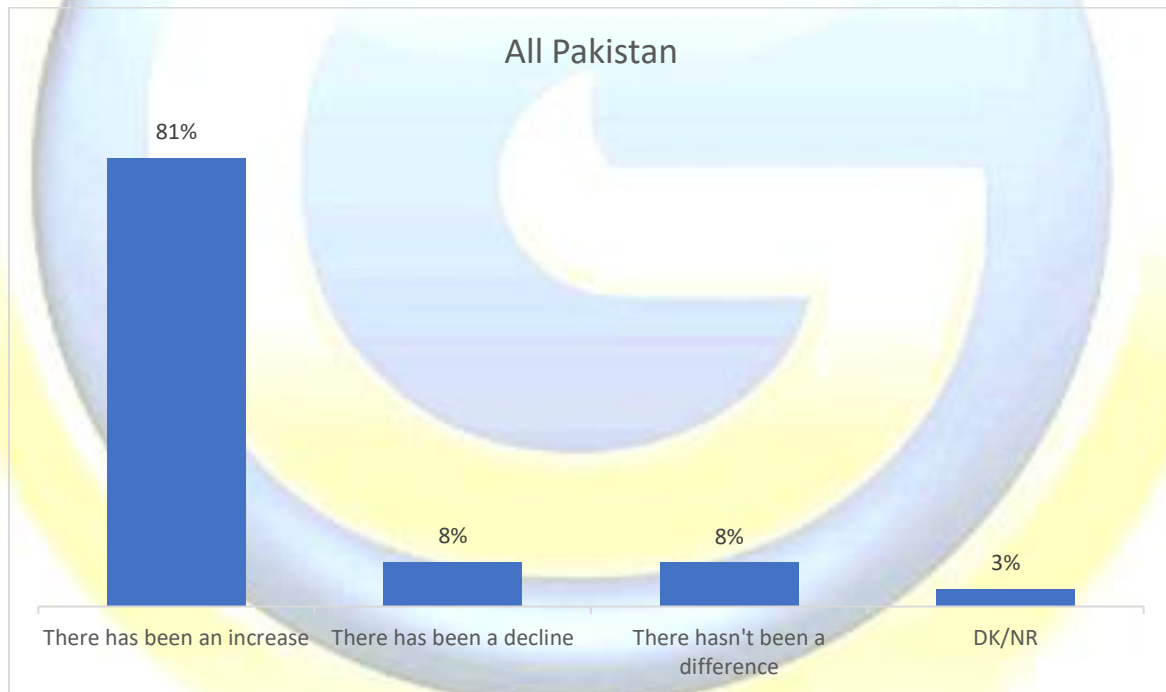
4 in 5 Pakistani's think that the difference between the rich and the poor has increased in the last one year: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), May 09th, 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 4 in 5 Pakistanis think that the difference between the rich and the poor has increased in the last one year.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country, was asked the question “*Considering the last one year, do you think that the difference between the rich and the poor has increased, decreased or there has been no difference during the last one year?*” In response, 81% said there has been an increase, 8% said there has been a decline, 8% said there hasn't been a difference while 3% did not respond or said that they did not know.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1135 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during 14 – 22 March 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI)
