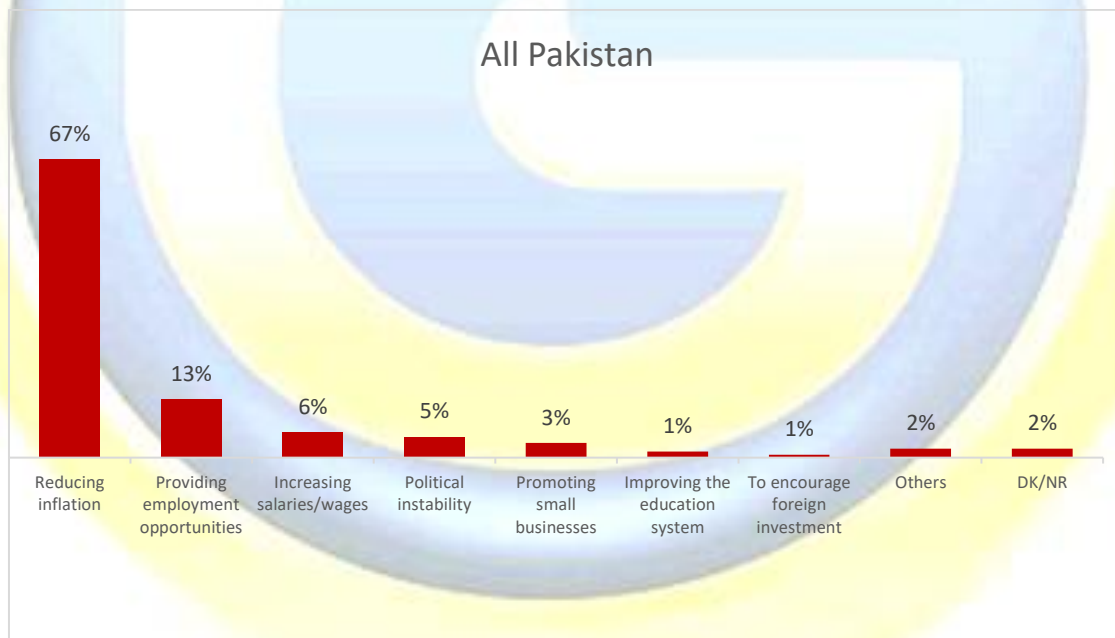

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 67% Pakistanis think reducing inflation is the most important thing the government can do to improve the economic conditions of Pakistan, 13% think providing employment opportunities is the way to go.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “Which of the following do you think is the most important thing the government can do to improve the economic conditions of Pakistan?” In response, 67% said reducing inflation, 13% said providing employment opportunities, 6% said increasing salaries/wages, 5% said political instability, 3% said promoting small businesses, 1% said improving the education system, 1% said to encourage foreign investment, 2% said others and 2% did not respond or said they did not know.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1135 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during 14 to 22 March 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI)
