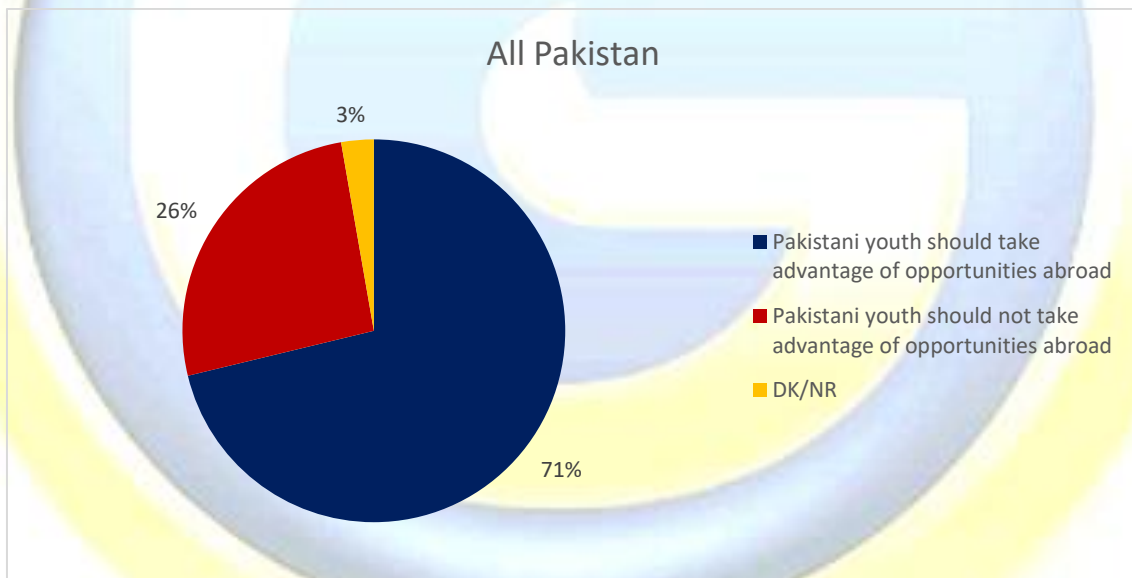
A huge majority of Pakistanis (71%) think that Pakistani youth should take advantage of opportunities abroad and there is no harm if they left the country: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), May 19th, 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, a huge majority of Pakistanis (71%) think that Pakistani youth should take advantage of opportunities abroad.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question “Some people believe that Pakistani youth should not go abroad for employment as it harms the country, while others believe that they should take advantage of the opportunities available abroad and this is the right way to go. What is your opinion?” In response, 71% said Pakistani youth should take advantage of opportunities abroad, 26% said Pakistani youth should not take advantage of opportunities abroad and 3% did not respond or said that they did not know.

Question: “Some people believe that Pakistani youth should not go abroad for employment as it harms the country, while others believe that they should take advantage of the opportunities available abroad and this is the right way to go. What is your opinion?”

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1135 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during 14 to 22 March 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI)
