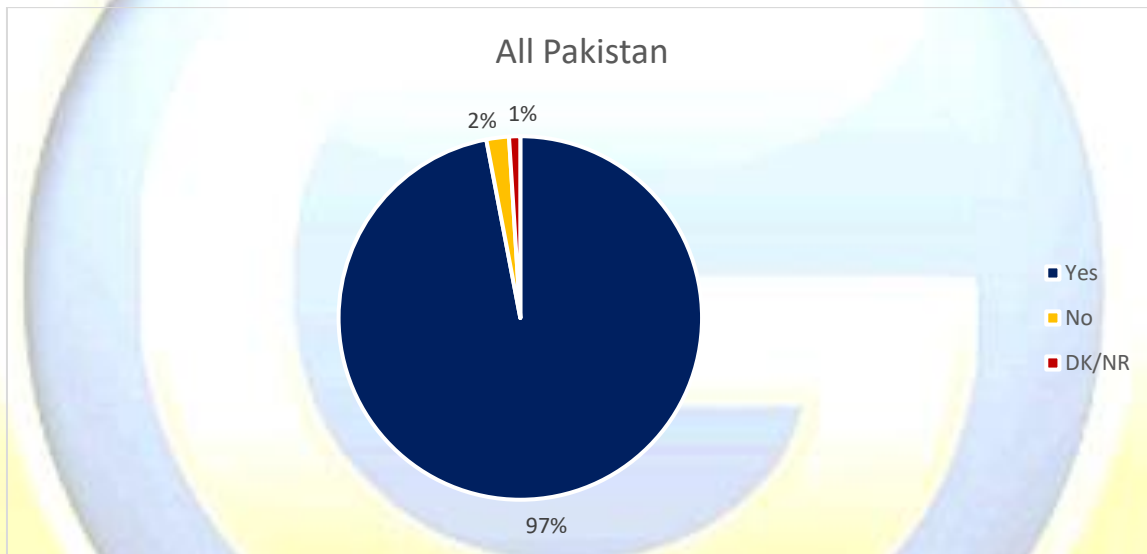
Almost all Pakistanis (97%) think that reducing the prices of food and drink items should be the government's top priority: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), May 29th, 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, almost all Pakistanis (97%) think that reducing the prices of food and drink items should be the government's top priority.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country, was asked the question *"Should reducing the prices of food and drink items be the government's top priority?"* In response, 97% said yes, and 2% said no.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1135 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during 14 to 22 March 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI)
