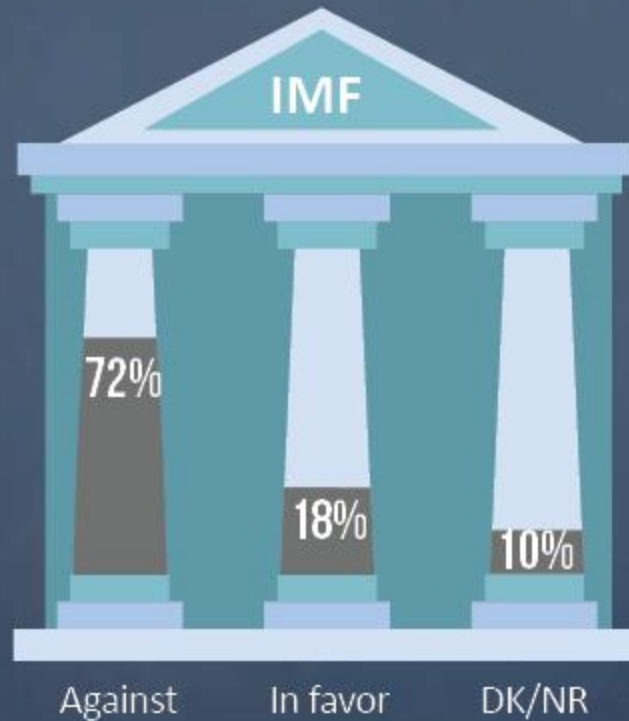

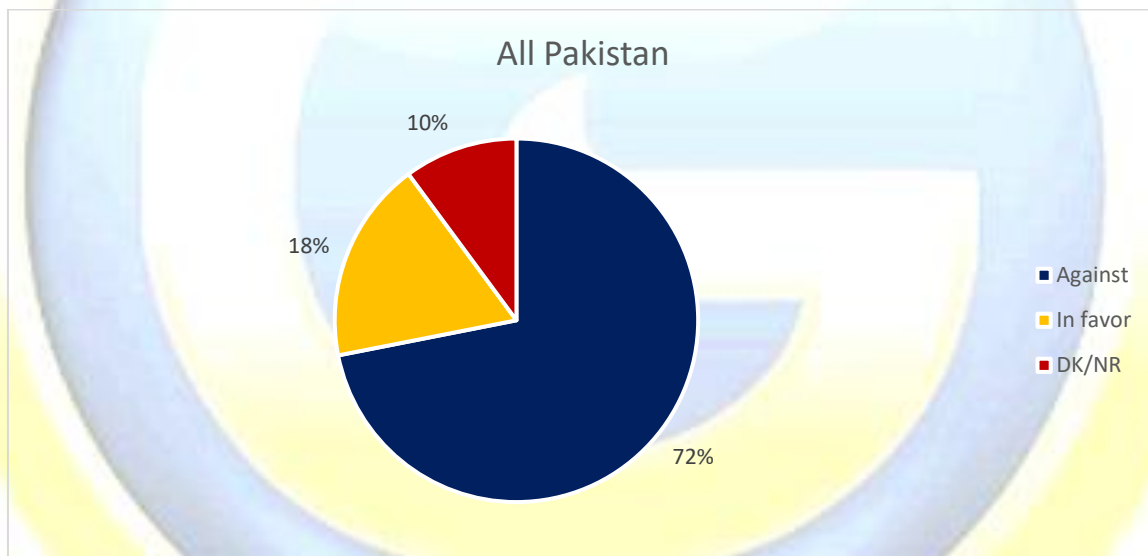
Almost 3/4th Pakistanis are against the government negotiating another deal with the IMF: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), May 30th, 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, almost 3/4th Pakistanis are against the government negotiating another deal with the IMF.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country, was asked the question “*Pakistan government is attempting to negotiate a deal with the IMF again, which will further burden the people with taxes and increase the cost of electricity and gas. Are you in favor or against the government negotiating another deal with the IMF?*” In response, 72% said they were against it, 18% said they were in favor of it and 10% did not respond or said that they did not know.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1135 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during 14 to 22 March 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI)
