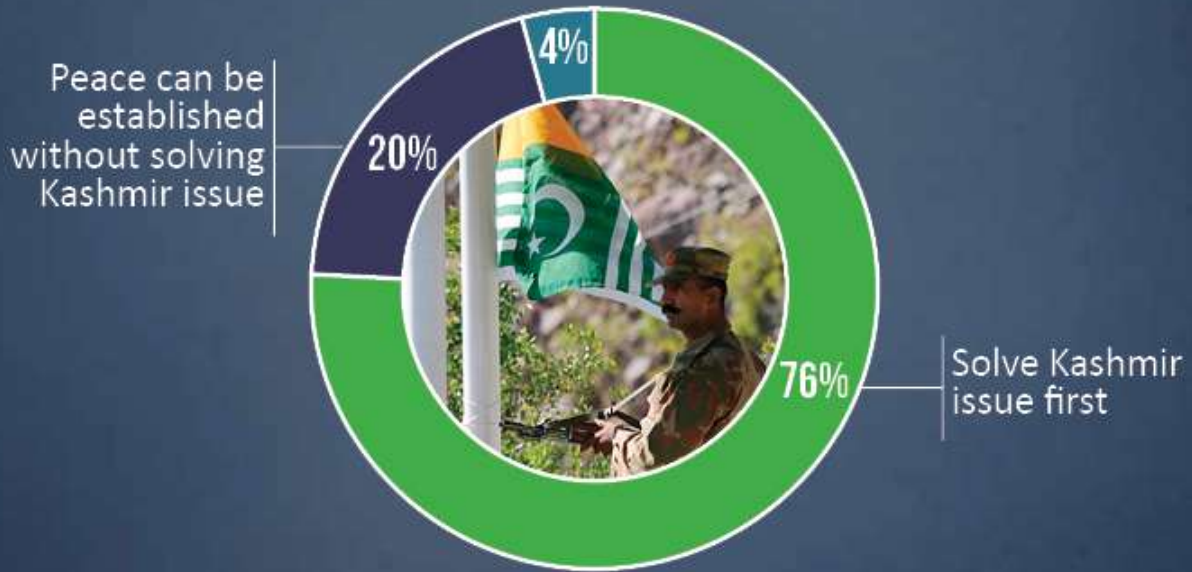

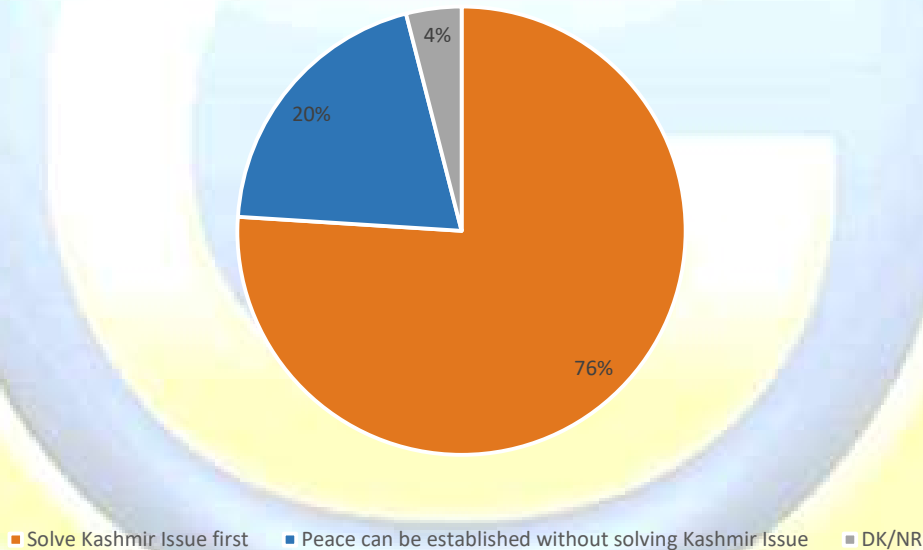
8 out of 10 Pakistanis believe it is important to solve the Kashmir Issue first in order to establish peace with India: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), June 8th, 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 8 out of 10 Pakistanis believe it is important to solve the Kashmir issue first in order to establish peace with India.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country, was asked the question “Do you believe it is important to solve the Kashmir issue first in order to establish peace with India?” In response, 76% said important to solve Kashmir issue before establishing peace with India, 20% said peace can be established even without solving Kashmir issue, and 4% said that they did not know or did not respond.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1535 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted during 29 March to 07 April 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI)
