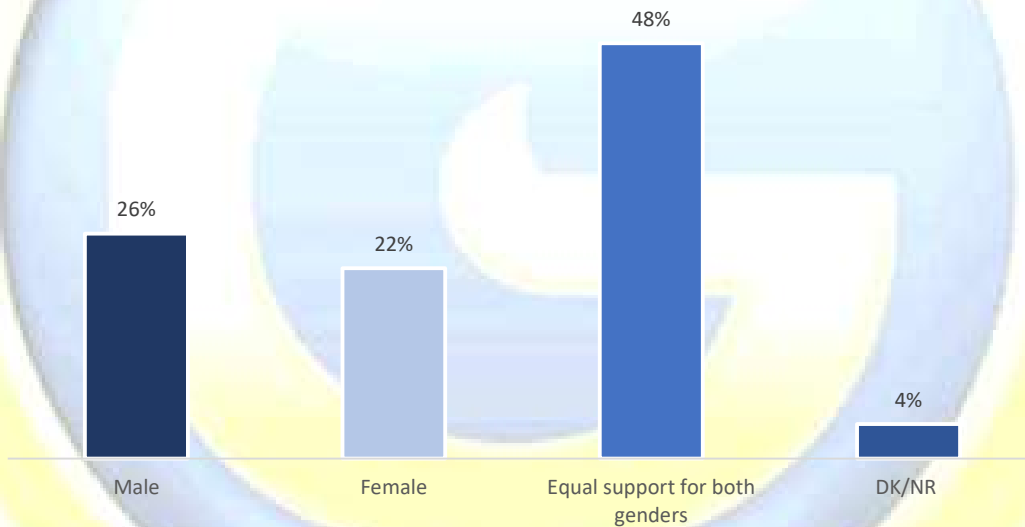
48% Pakistanis show equal support for both Genders when it comes to appointment at office: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), June 13th, 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 48% Pakistanis show equal support for both Genders when it comes to appointment at office.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country, was asked the question “*Suppose two people are nominated for appointment to an office and both of them have the same qualifications except one is male and one is female, please state which of the two people would you prefer/support for appointment to the office?*” In response, 26% said male, 22% said female, 48% said equal support for both regardless of gender, and 4% said that they did not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1535 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted during 29 March to 07 April 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI)
