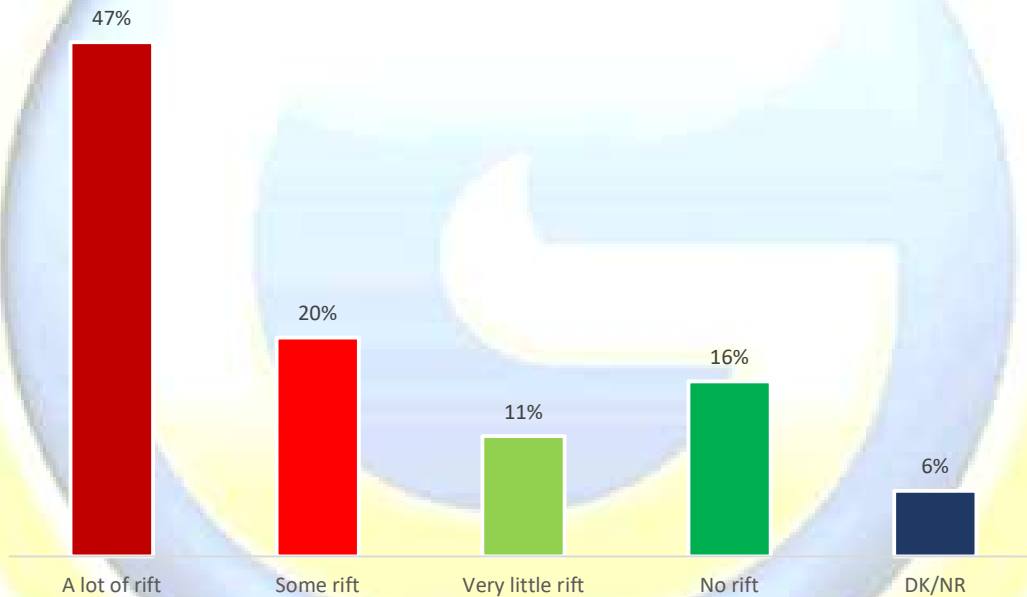
47% Pakistanis believe there is a significant rift between the rich and the poor in Pakistan: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), June 14th, 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 47% Pakistanis believe there is a significant rift between the rich and the poor in Pakistan.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country, was asked the question “*In your opinion, how much rift is there between the rich and poor in Pakistan?*” In response, 47% said a lot of rift between rich and poor, 20% said some rift between rich and poor, 11% said very little rift between rich and poor, 16% said no rift between rich and poor and 6% said that they did not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1535 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted during 29 March to 07 April 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI)
