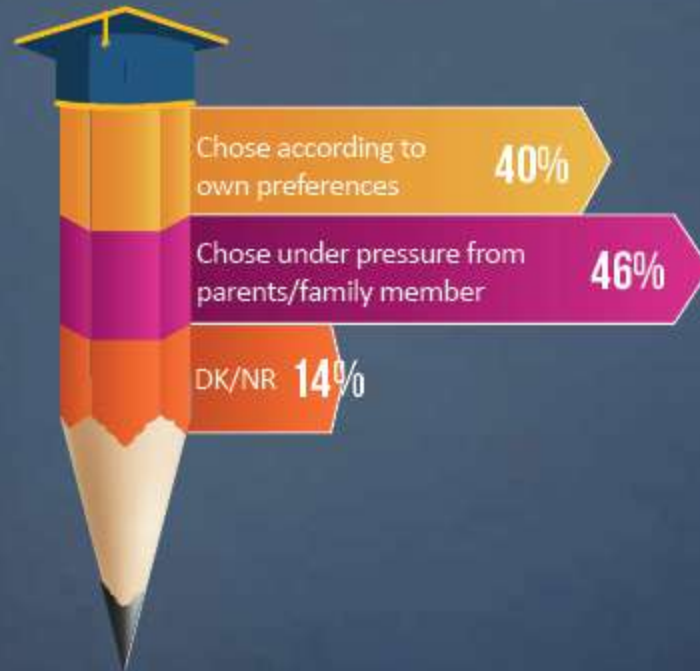

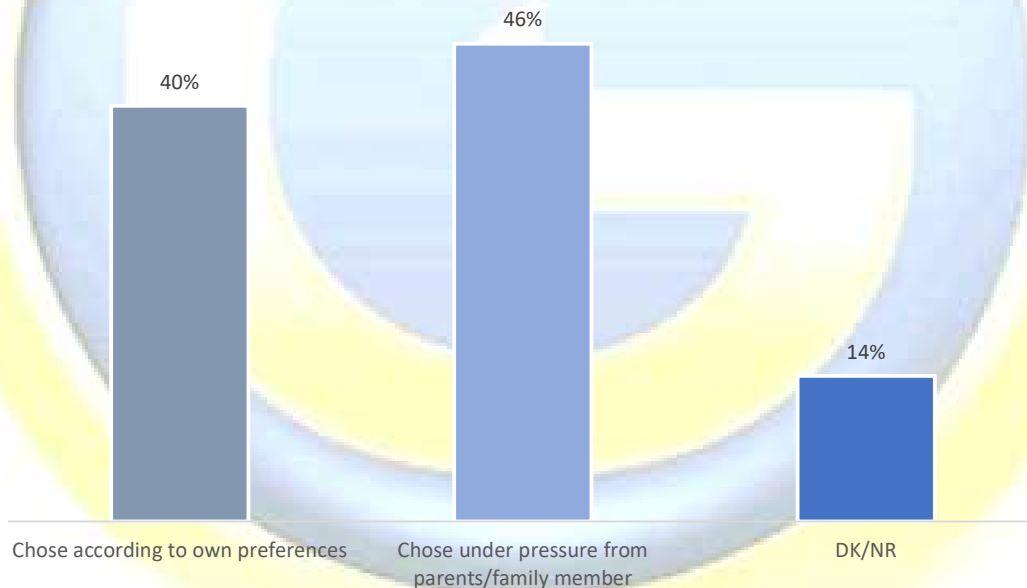
46% Pakistanis chose their educational field under pressure from parents or family members: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), June 20th, 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 46% of Pakistanis chose their educational field under pressure from parents or family members.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country, was asked the question *“Please indicate whether the educational program/field you are studying in or have studied in is one that you chose according to your own preferences or whether it was chosen under pressure from parents or a family member?”* In response, 40% said chose according to own preferences, 46% said chose under pressure from parents/family member, and 14% said they do not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1535 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted during 29 March to 07 April 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI)
