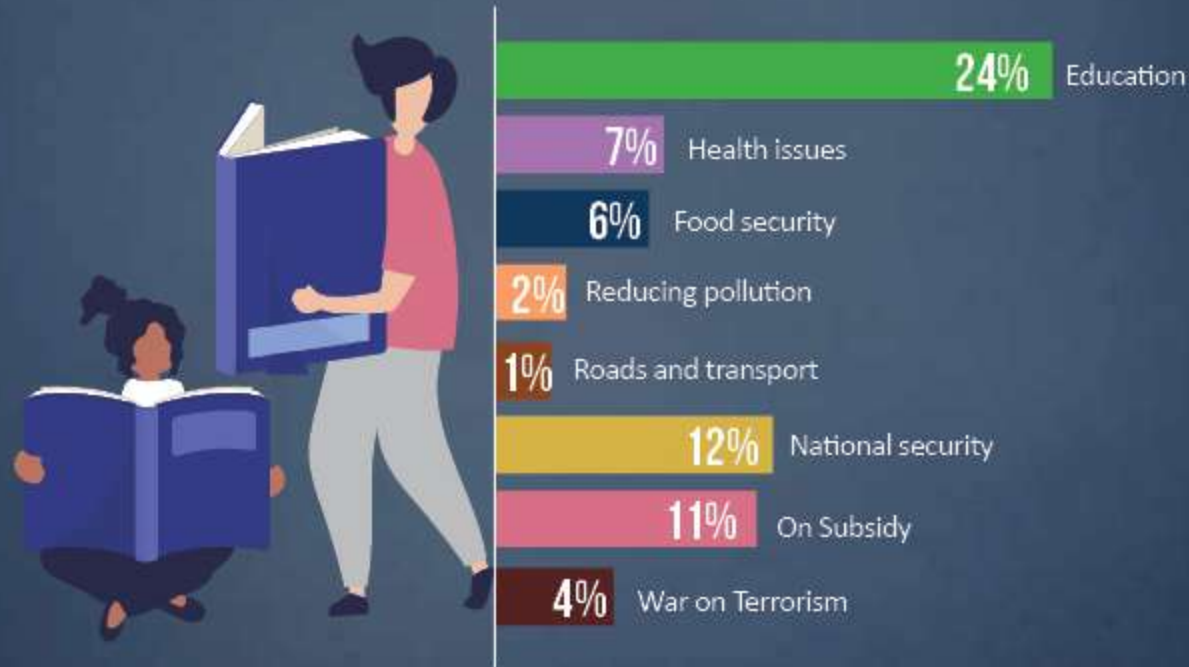

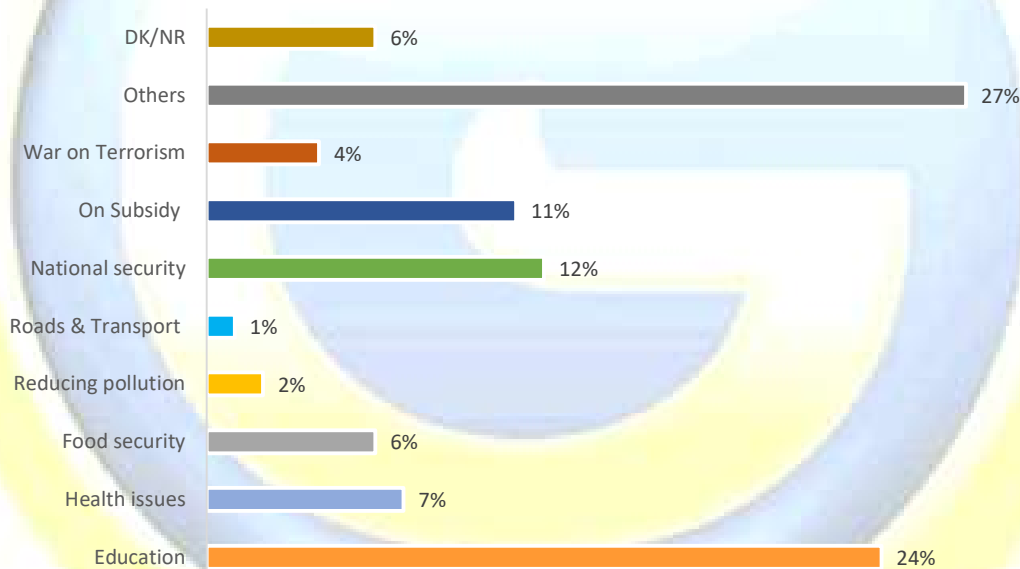
Almost one in four Pakistanis (24%) believe top priority for Pakistani government should be education as compared to other issues: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), June 26th, 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 24% of Pakistanis believe the top priority for our government should be education as compared to other issues.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country, was asked the question “Which of the following issues do you think should be the top priority of our government?” In response, 24% said on education, 7% said on health issues, 6% said on food security, 2% said on reducing pollution, 1% said on roads and transport issues, 12% said on national security, 11% said on Subsidy (Government Assistance), 4% said on war on Terrorism, 27% said Others, and 6% said that they do not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1535 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted during 29 March to 07 April 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI)
