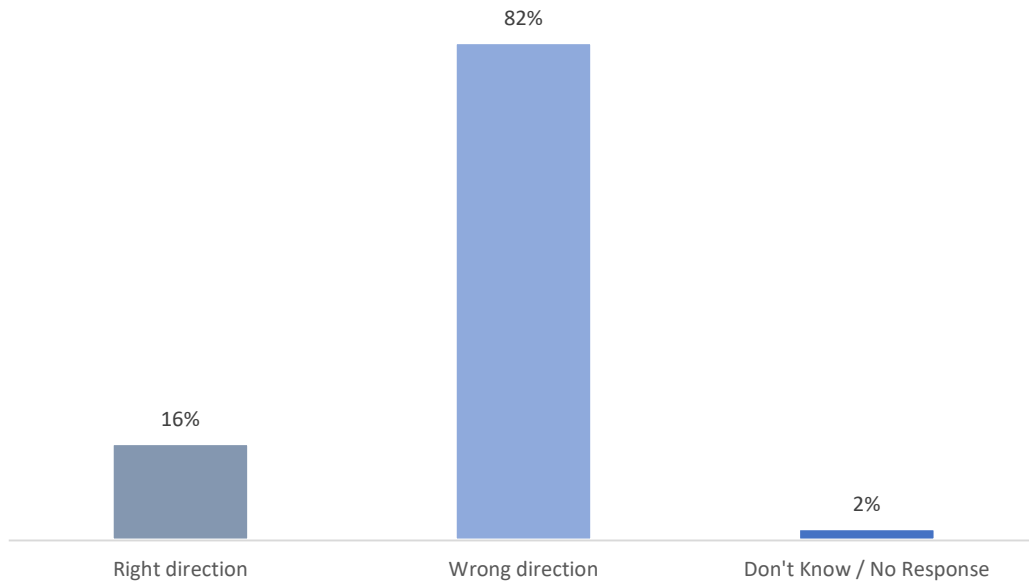
4 out of 5 Pakistanis think our country is going in the wrong direction: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), July 4th, 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 4 out of 5 (82%) Pakistanis think our country is going in the wrong direction.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country, was asked the question. “Do you think our country is going in the right direction?” In response, 16% said right direction, 82% said wrong direction and 2% said they do not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1535 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted during 29 March to 07 April 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI)
