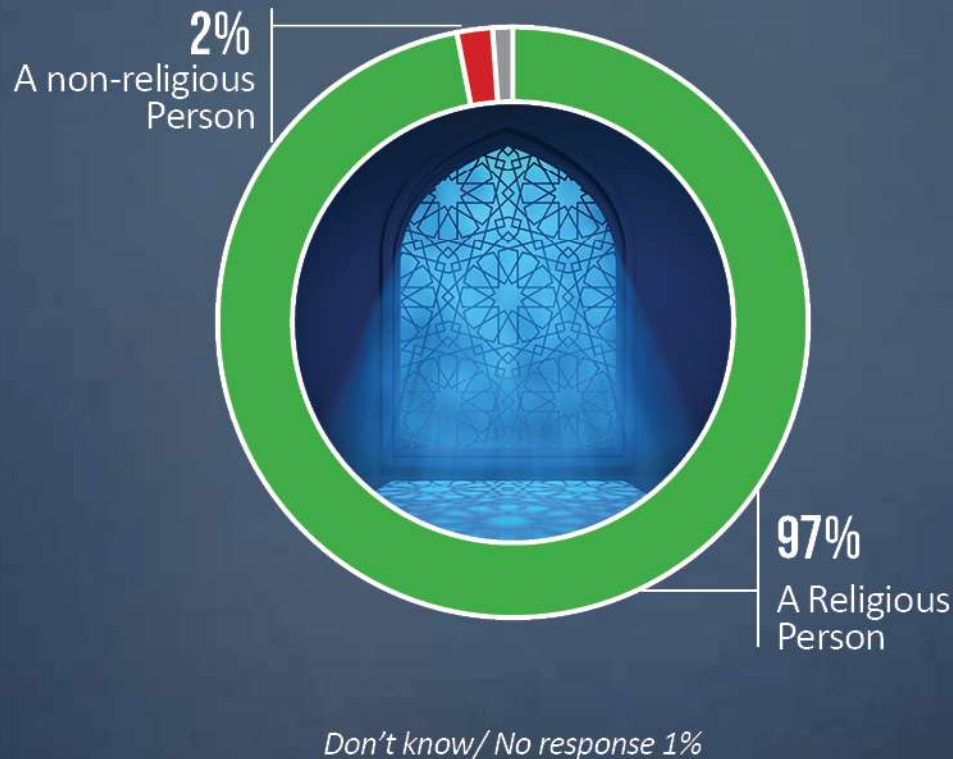

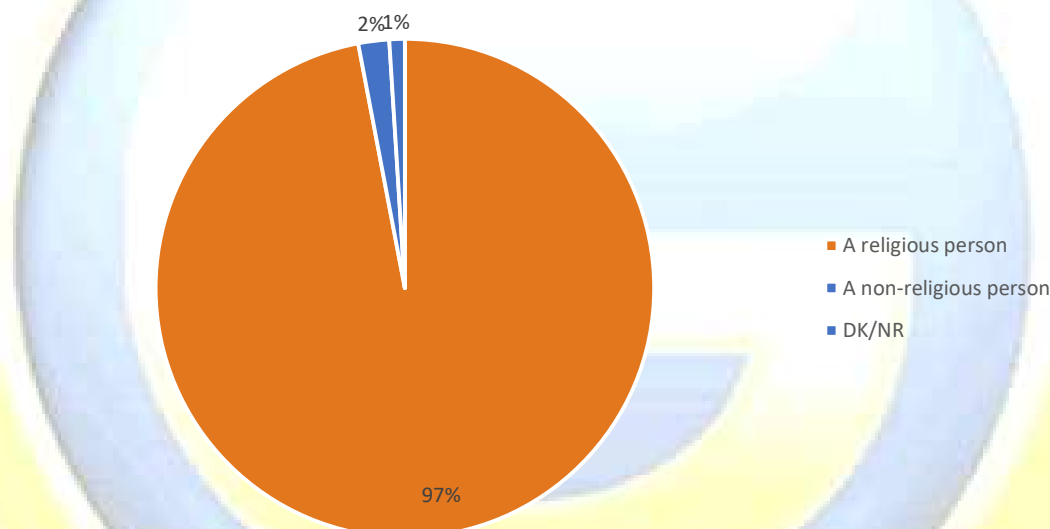
97% of Pakistanis perceive themselves as religious: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), July 07th, 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 97% of Pakistanis perceive themselves as religious.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country, was asked the question “(Excluding daily prayers or religious obligations) please respond with what kind of person do you perceive yourself to be?” In response, 97% said they think of themselves as religious, 2% said they think of themselves as non-religious, and 1% said that they do not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1462 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted during 03 August to 24 August 2022. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI)
