93% of married Pakistanis felt satisfied with their spouse's treatment of them with dignity and respect: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

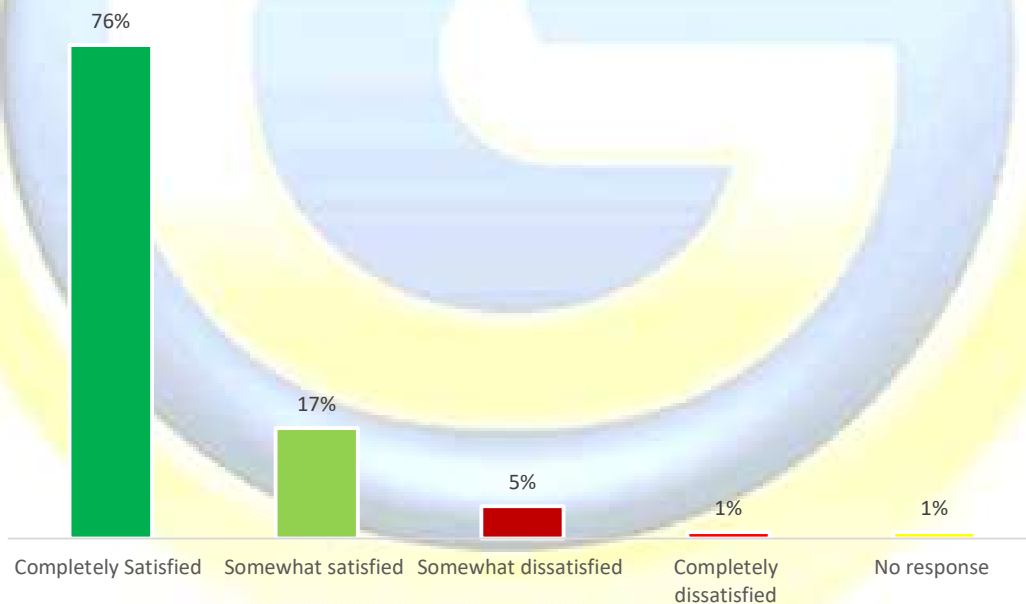

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 93% of married Pakistanis felt satisfied with their spouse's treatment of them with dignity and respect.

A nationally representative sample of married adult men and women from across the country, was asked the question *"Considering your married life, please tell me to what extent are you satisfied with your spouse regarding 'Treating with dignity and respect'?"* In response, 76% said completely satisfied, 17% said somewhat satisfied, 5% said somewhat dissatisfied, 1% said completely dissatisfied, and 1% gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 929 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted during 07 July to 16 July 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
