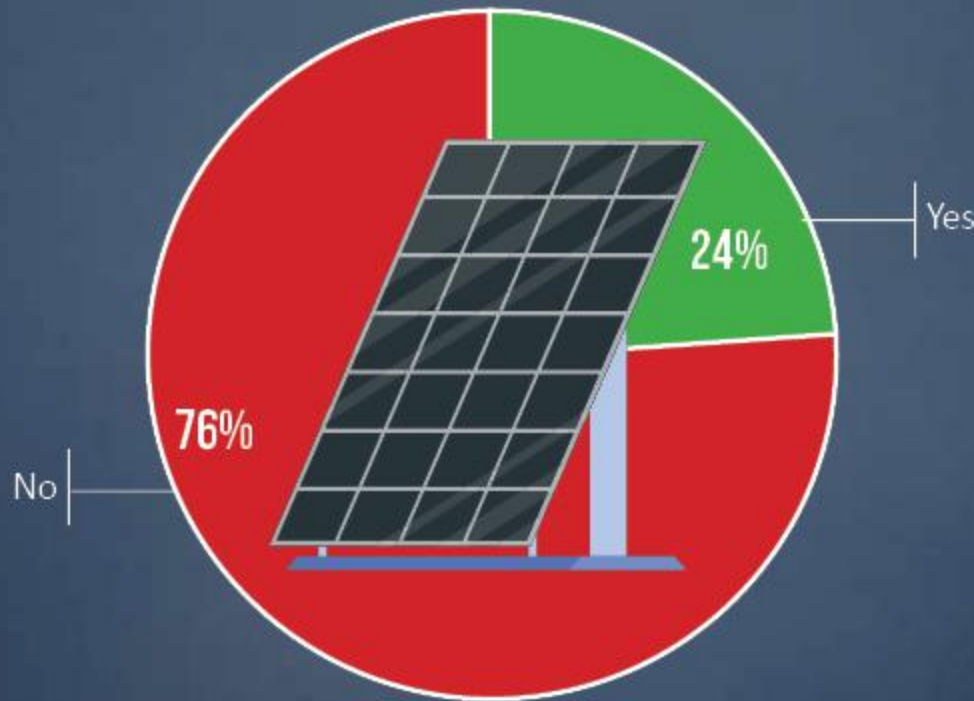

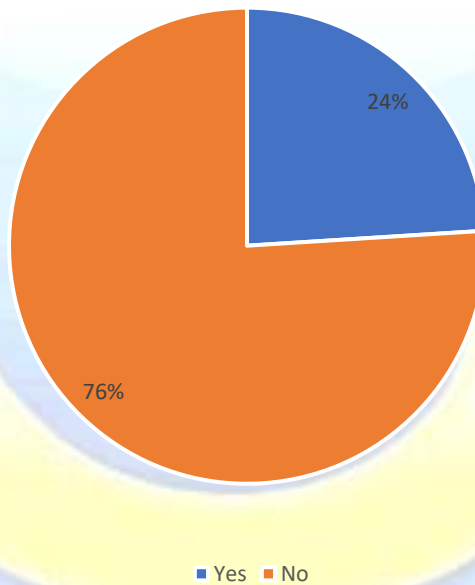
24% Pakistanis have a device at home that runs on Solar Energy: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), September 14th, 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 24% Pakistanis have a device at home that runs on solar energy.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country, was asked the question “Do you have any gadget or device at your home that runs on solar energy?” In response, 24% said yes, and 76% said no.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 853 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted during 24 August to 28 August 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).

STAT OF THE DAY
