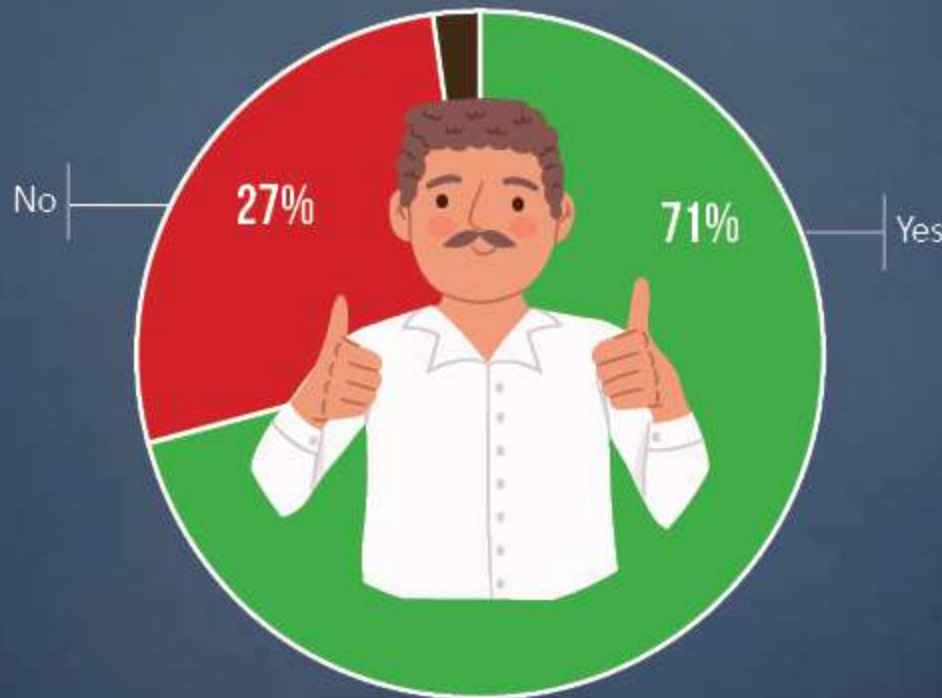

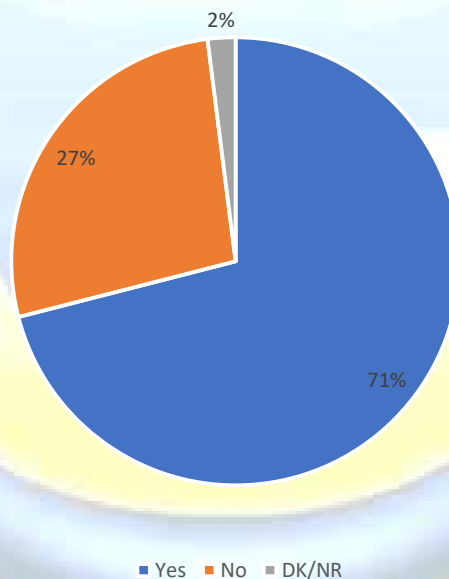
Majority Pakistanis are of the view that the older generation was more obedient than the new generation: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), September 20th, 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, majority Pakistanis are of the view that the older generation was more obedient than the new generation.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country, was asked the question “*Imagine you are asked to compare the new generation with the previous generation. Considering the following aspects, share your thoughts on whether the new generation is more or less...? - Is the new generation more disobedient than the previous generation?*” In response, 71% said yes, 27% said no and 2% said that they do not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 853 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted during 24 August to 28 August 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
