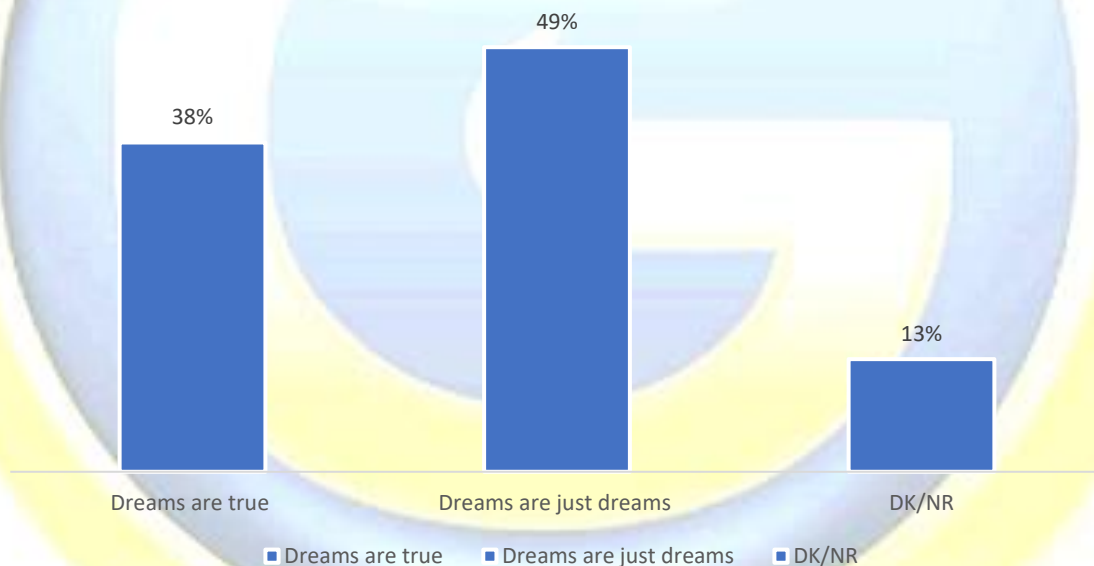
2 in 5 Pakistanis believe that dreams transcend mere fantasy, carrying a significant truth within them: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), September 4th, 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 2 in 5 Pakistanis believe that dreams transcend mere fantasy, carrying a significant truth within them.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country, was asked the question “Some people believe that dreams are true, while others believe that dreams are just dreams. What is your opinion on this?” In response, 38% said dreams are true, 49% said dreams are just dreams and 13% said they do not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 929 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted during 07 July to 16 July 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).

STAT OF THE DAY

The literacy rate among the richest quintile is 79% while in the poorest it is 30%.
