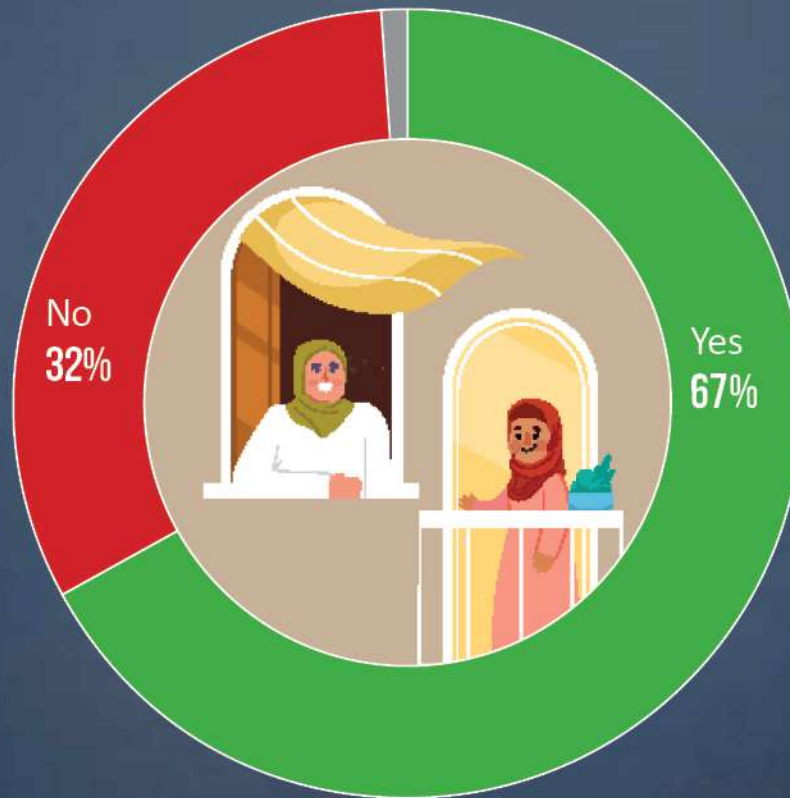

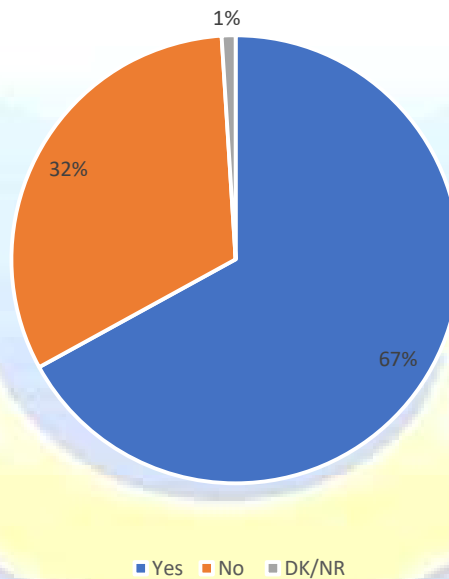
Nearly 70% Pakistanis engaged in conversations with neighbors in the past week: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), September 6th, 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, nearly 70% Pakistanis engaged in conversations with neighbors in the past week.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country, was asked the question “During the past week, have you had a conversation with your neighbors, even if it was for a short time?” In response, 67% said yes, 32% said no, and 1% said they do not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 929 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted during 07 July to 16 July 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
