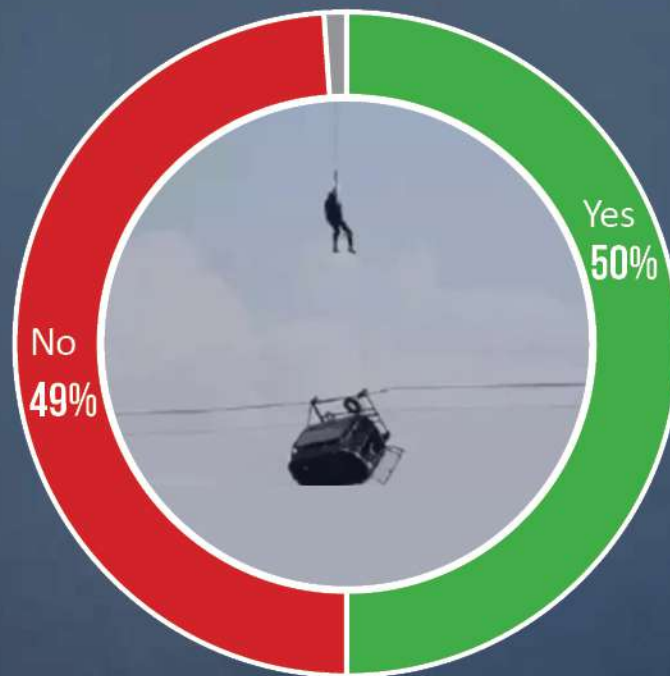

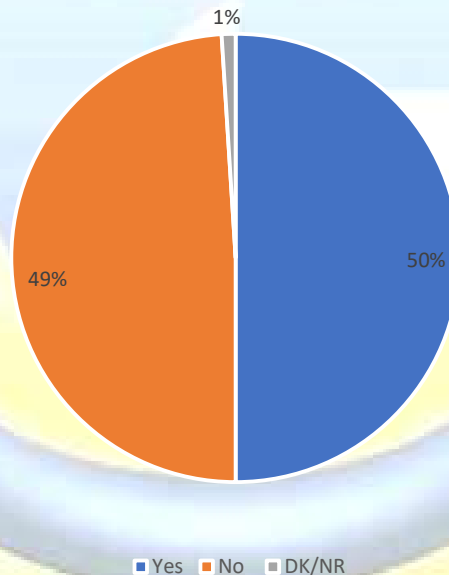

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 50% Pakistanis were aware of the recent incident in Battagram, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, where 8 individuals were trapped in a chairlift.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country, was asked the question “Recently, in the city of Battagram in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, 8 individuals were trapped in a chairlift. Ultimately, with the help of Pakistan Army soldiers and local people, they were rescued through a risky operation. Have you heard/read about this incident?” In response, 50% said yes, 49% said no and 1% said that they do not know or gave no response.

Question: “Recently, in the city of Battagram in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, 8 individuals were trapped in a chairlift. Ultimately, with the help of Pakistan Army soldiers and local people, they were rescued through a risky operation. Have you heard/read about this incident?”

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 853 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted during 24 August to 28 August 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
