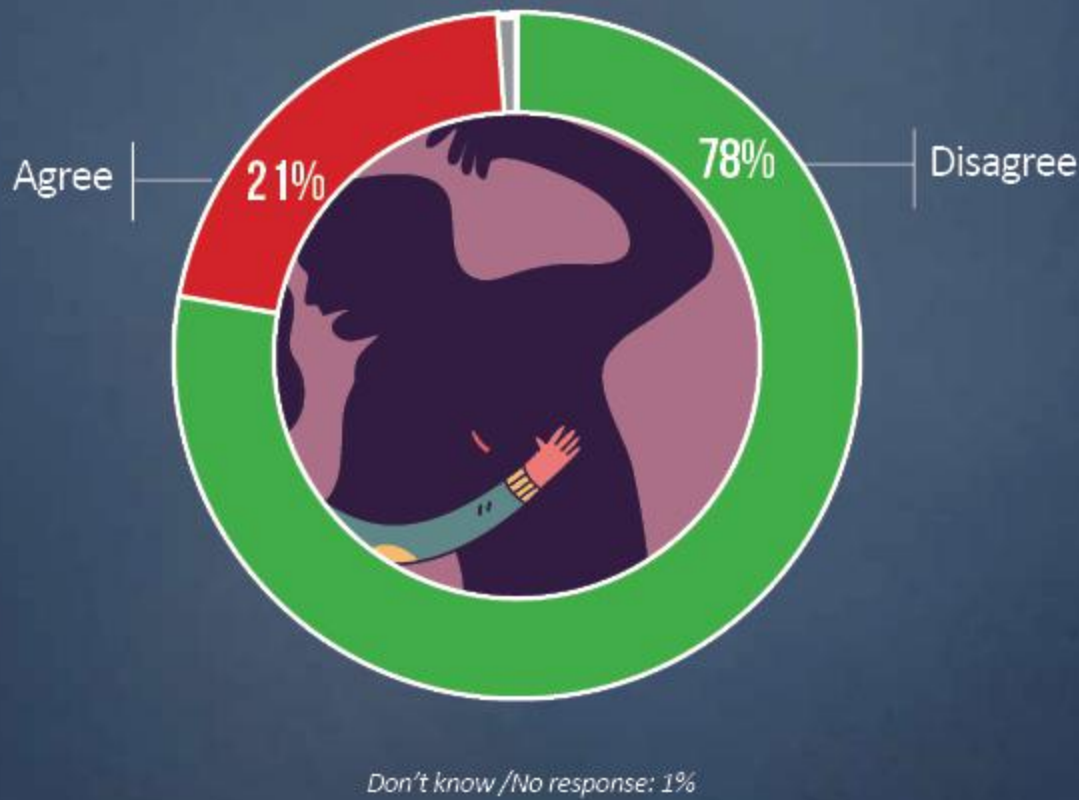

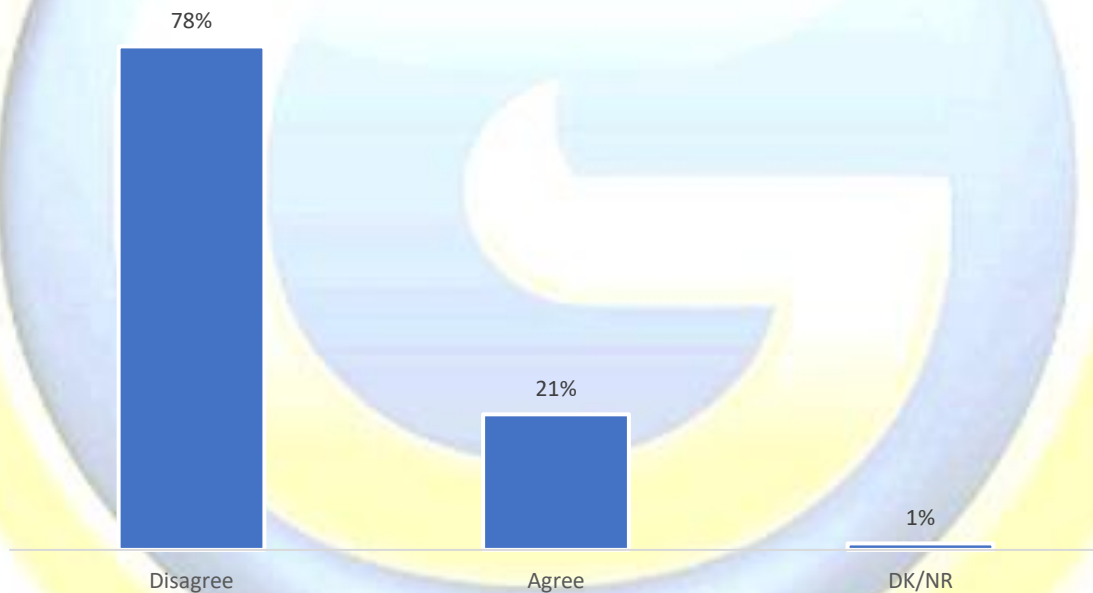
21% Pakistani adult men and women say there can be justified reasons for husband hitting wife: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), October 17th, 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 21% Pakistani adult men and women say there can be justified reasons for husband hitting wife.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country, was asked the question “Please tell me to what extent you agree or disagree with the following statements? - Husbands can hit their wives under certain circumstances, and it's not wrong?” In response, 78% said they disagree with the statement, 21% said they agree with the statement, and 1% said that they do not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 853 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted during 24 August to 28 August 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
