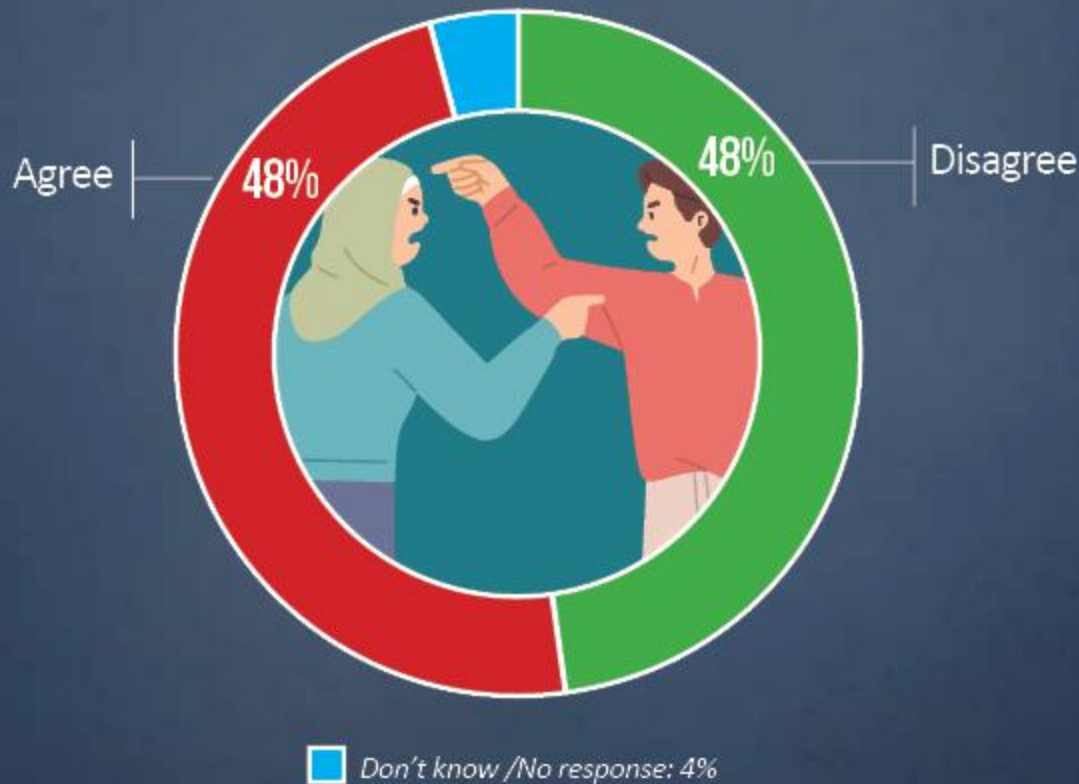

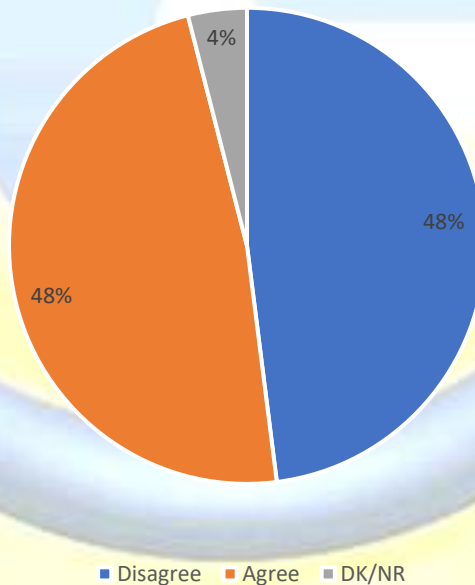
In the past 6 months, while nearly half of Pakistanis (48%) said they were aware of a husband-and-wife fighting, the same proportion reported being unaware: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, in the past 6 months, while nearly half of Pakistanis (48%) said they were aware of a husband-and-wife fighting, the same proportion reported being unaware.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country, was asked the question “Please tell me to what extent you agree or disagree with the following statements? - In the past 6 months, I have witnessed or heard about a husband and wife fighting.” In response, 48% said they agree with the statement ‘In the past 6 months, I have witness or heard about a husband and wife fighting’, 48% said they disagree with the statement ‘In the past 6 months, I have witness or heard about a husband and wife fighting’, and 4% said that they do not know or gave no response.

Question: “Please tell me to what extent you agree or disagree with the following statements? - In the past 6 months, I have witnessed or heard about a husband and wife fighting.”

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 853 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted during 24 August to 28 August 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
