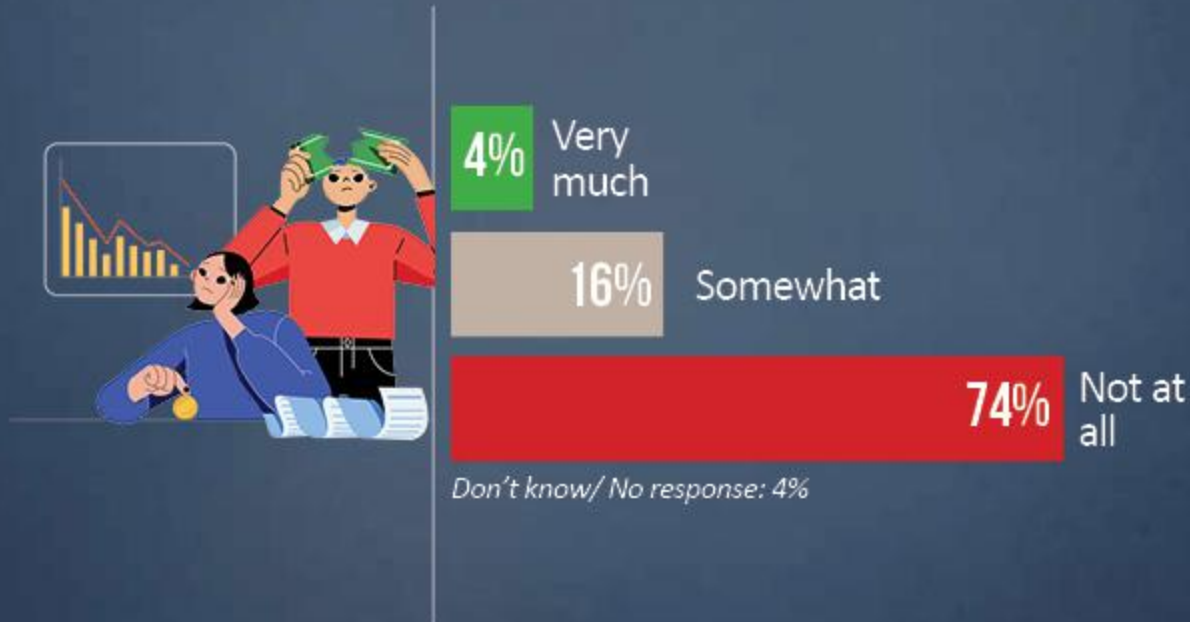

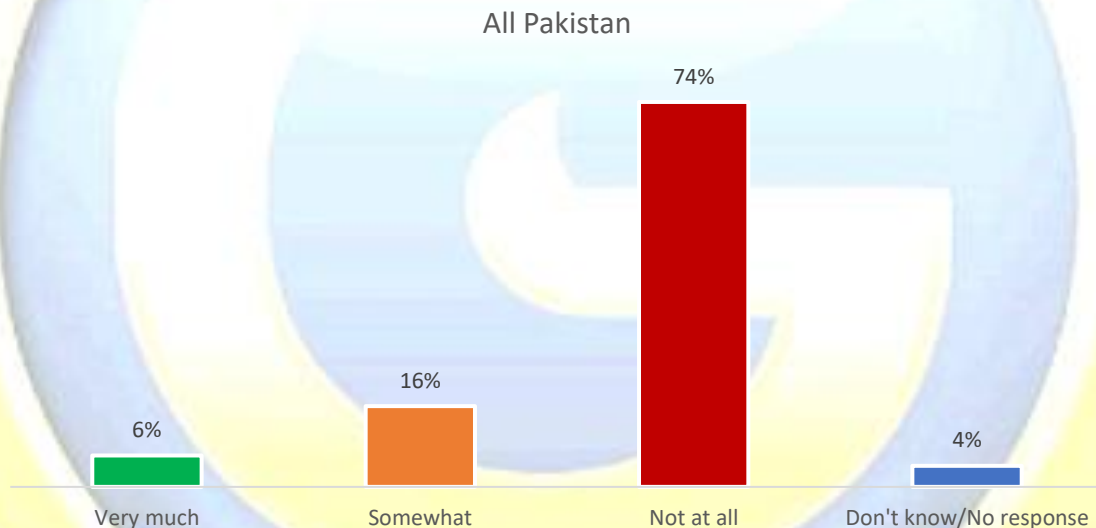
3 in 4 (74%) Pakistanis think that the current caretaker government has not at all been successful in reducing inflation: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), 30th October 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 3 in 4 (74%) Pakistanis think that the current caretaker government has not at all been successful in reducing inflation.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “In your opinion, how successful has the current caretaker government been overall in reducing the following issues in the country? - Reducing inflation” In response, 6% said ‘very much’, 16% said ‘somewhat’, 74% said ‘not at all’, and 4% said that they did not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,000 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 4th to 16th October 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
