6 in 10 Pakistanis feel that the financial benefits for working women are greater than the various disadvantages, while 32% have the opposite opinion: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 6 in 10 Pakistanis feel that the financial benefits for working women are greater than the various disadvantages, while 32% have the opposite opinion.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “Some people believe that the financial benefits for working women are greater than the various disadvantages, while others have the opposite opinion. What is your opinion?” In response, 61% said ‘financial benefits are greater than various disadvantages’, 32% said ‘it’s not like that’, and 7% said that they did not know or gave no response.

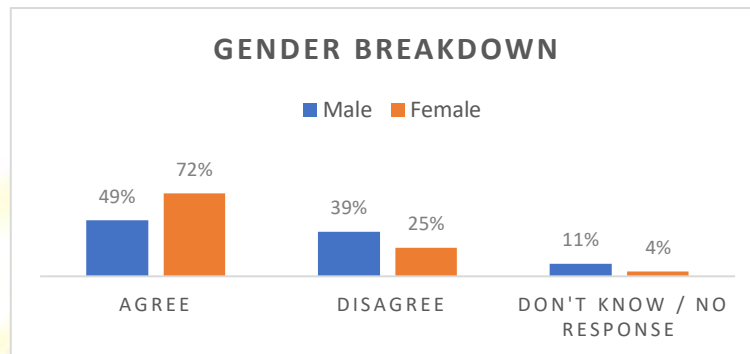
Question: Some people believe that the financial benefits for working women are greater than the various disadvantages, while others have the opposite opinion. What is your opinion?

GENDER BREAKDOWN: The gender breakdown suggests that while 72% of women agreed with the statement, less than half (49%) of men agreed as well.

There is a 23% difference between women and men who believe that the financial advantages for working women are greater than the various disadvantages



The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,303 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from October 17th to November 7th 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
