An almost unanimous 91% of Pakistanis align their sympathies with the Palestinians of Gaza, while only 2% report sympathizing with Israel: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), 22nd November, 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, an almost unanimous 91% of Pakistanis align their sympathies with the Palestinians of Gaza, while only 2% report sympathizing with Israel.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “Recently there is war going on between Israel and Palestinians in Gaza. Are your sympathies with Israel or Palestinians of Gaza?” 91% said ‘Palestinians of Gaza’, 2% said ‘Israel’, 1% said ‘both’, and 6% said that they did not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 802 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted during 2nd November to 6th November 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 3 -5 percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
