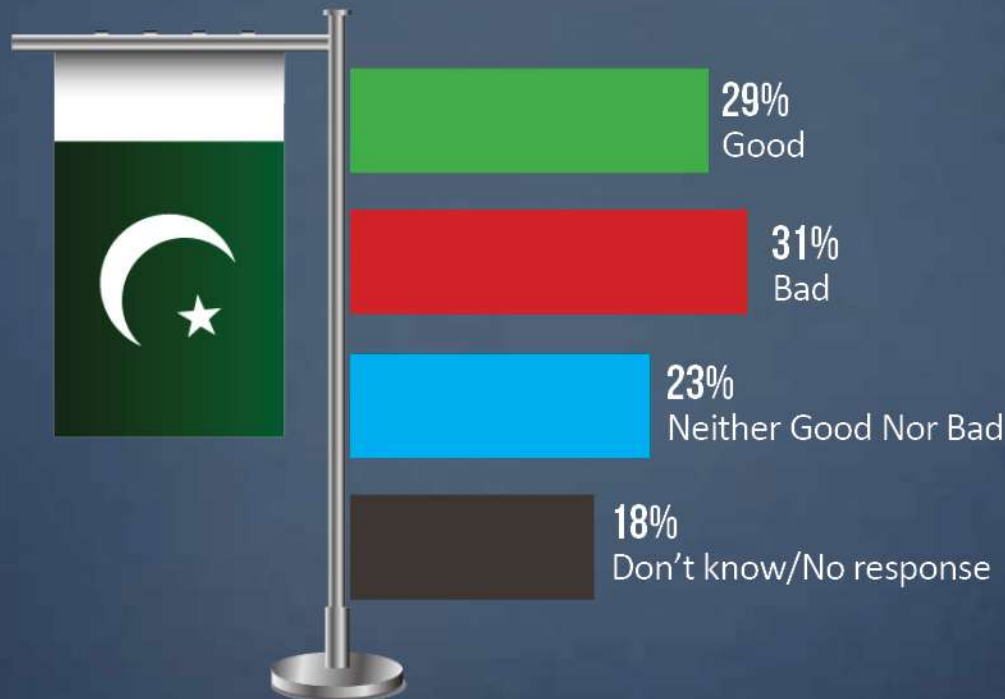

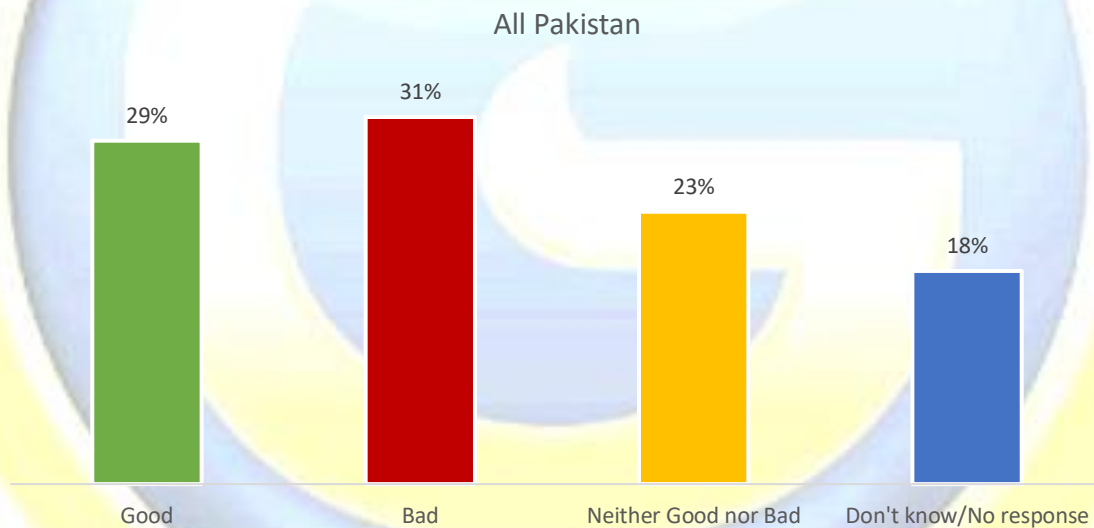
3 out of 10 (31%) Pakistanis do not look favorably upon the policy of their own government regarding the ongoing Israel-Palestine war: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), 30th November 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 3 out of 10 (31%) Pakistanis do not look favorably upon the policy of their own government regarding the ongoing Israel-Palestine war.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “What is your view about the policy of the government of your own country about the war in Palestine. The policy of your government, is it:” 29% said ‘good’, 31% said ‘bad’, 23% said ‘neither good nor bad’, and 18% said that they did not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 802 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted during 2nd November to 6th November 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 3 -5 percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
