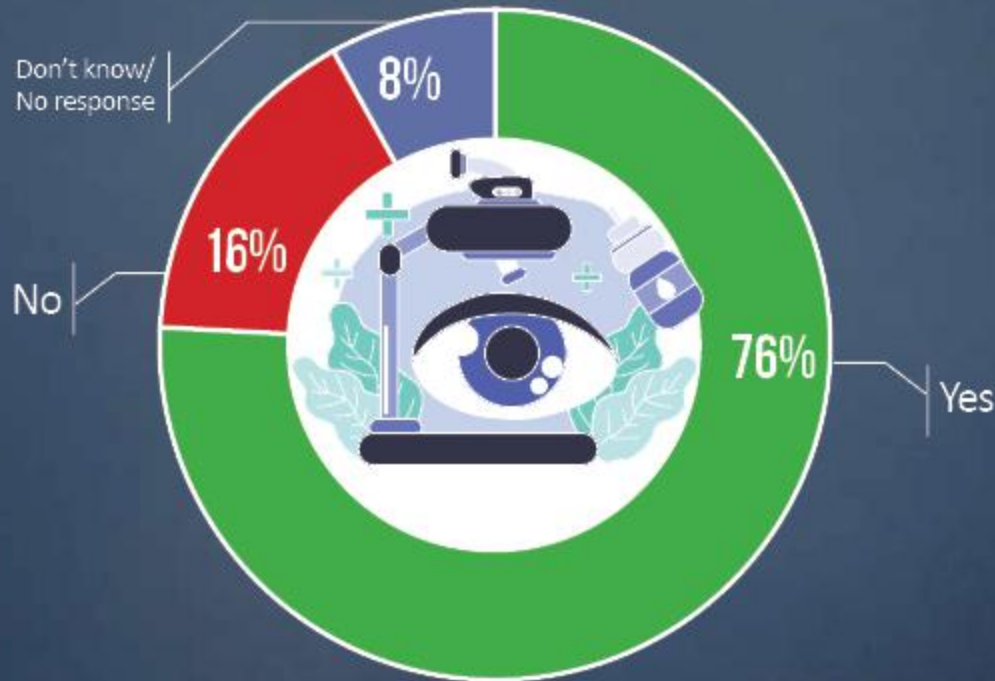

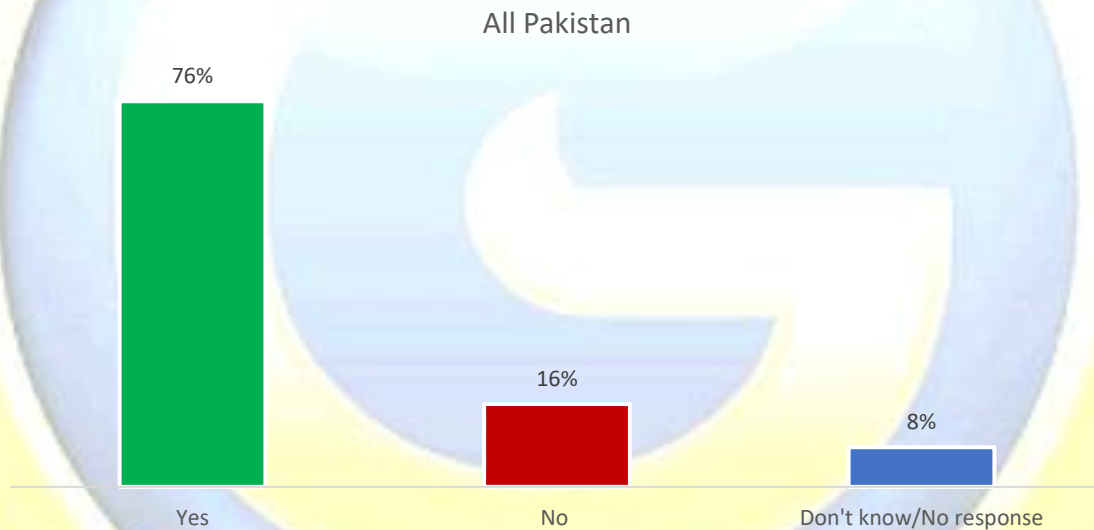
16% of Pakistanis believe Pink Eye Virus is not contagious, another 8% say they don't know if it is contagious or not: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), 3rd November 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 16% of Pakistanis believe Pink Eye Virus is not contagious, another 8% say they don't know if it is contagious or not.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, *"In your opinion, is the eye disease outbreak a contagious disease, meaning it can spread from one person to another?"* In response, 76% said 'yes', 16% said 'no', and 8% said that they did not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,000 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 4th to 16th October 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
