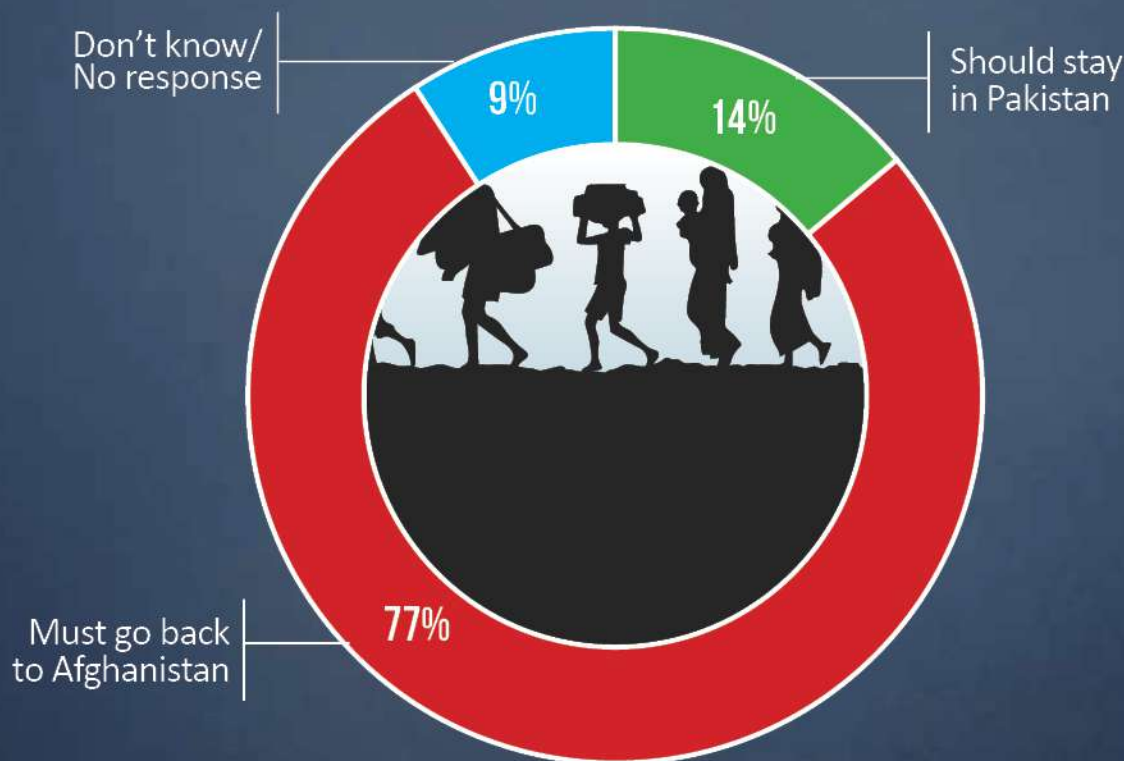

77% of Pakistanis opine that Afghan refugees must go back to Afghanistan while 14% think they can stay in Pakistan: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), 1st December, 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 77% of Pakistanis opine that Afghan refugees must go back to Afghanistan while 14% think they can stay in Pakistan.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “Please tell me whether you think Afghan refugees should stay in Pakistan or go back to their country?” 14% said ‘should stay in Pakistan’, 77% said ‘must go back to Afghanistan’, and 9% said that they did not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 752 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted during 1st November to 4th November 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 3 -5 percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
