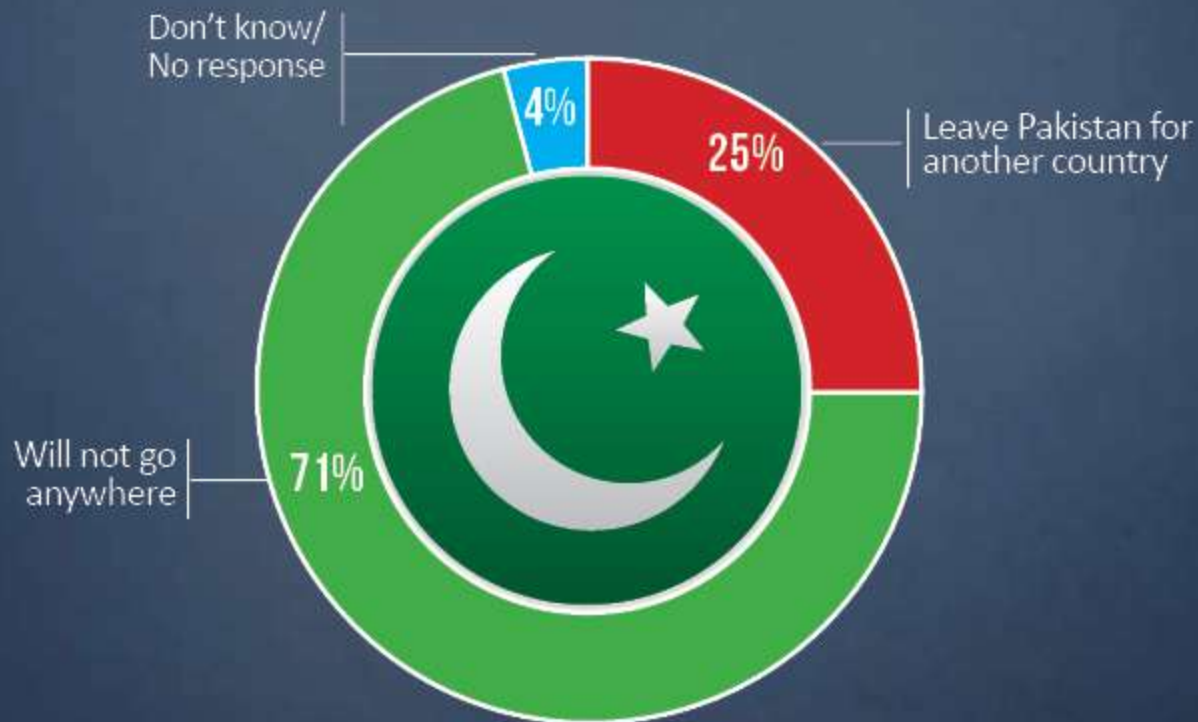

7 IN 10 PAKISTANIS (71%) BELIEVE THAT NO MATTER HOW BAD THE SITUATION IN PAKISTAN IS, THEY WILL NOT LEAVE FOR ANOTHER COUNTRY IF THEY HAD THE OPPORTUNITY: GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN

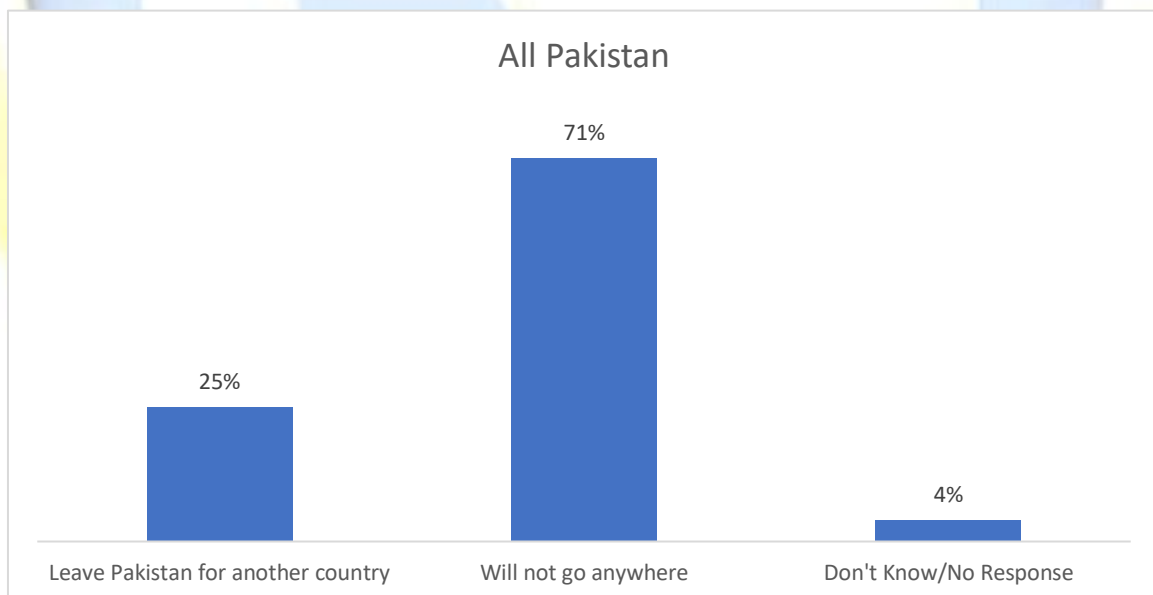

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 7 in 10 Pakistanis (71%) believe that no matter how bad the situation in Pakistan is, they will not leave for another country if they had the opportunity.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “Some people believe that the current law and order situation in Pakistan is very bad, so they would leave Pakistan for another country if they had the opportunity. Others believe that no matter how bad the situation in Pakistan is, they will not leave. In your opinion, what would you do in this situation?” In response, 25% said ‘leave Pakistan for another country’, 71% said ‘will not go anywhere’, and 4% said that they did not know or gave no response.

Question: Some people believe that the current law and order situation in Pakistan is very bad, so they would leave Pakistan for another country if they had the opportunity. Others believe that no matter how bad the situation in Pakistan is, they will not leave. In your opinion, what would you do in this situation?

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,303 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from October 17th to November 7th 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
