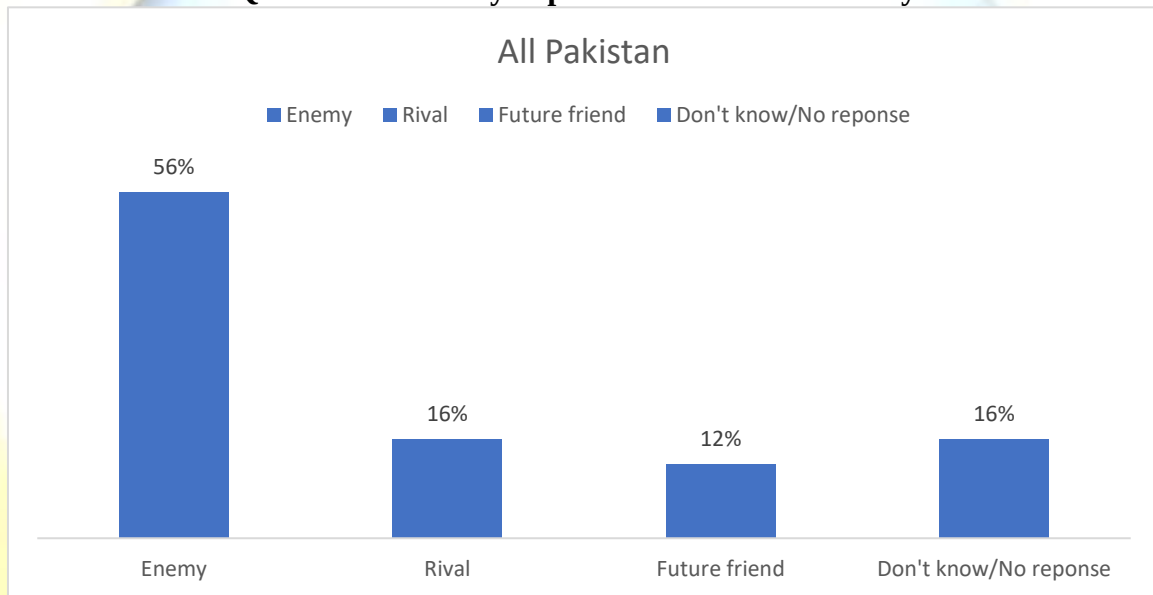
56% Pakistanis perceive India as an enemy

(Islamabad) 29th, December 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 56% Pakistanis perceive India as an enemy.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “*How do you perceive India as a country?*” In response, 56% said ‘Enemy’, 16% said ‘Rival’, 12% said ‘Future Friend’, and 16% said that they did not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,303 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from October 17th to November 7th 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
