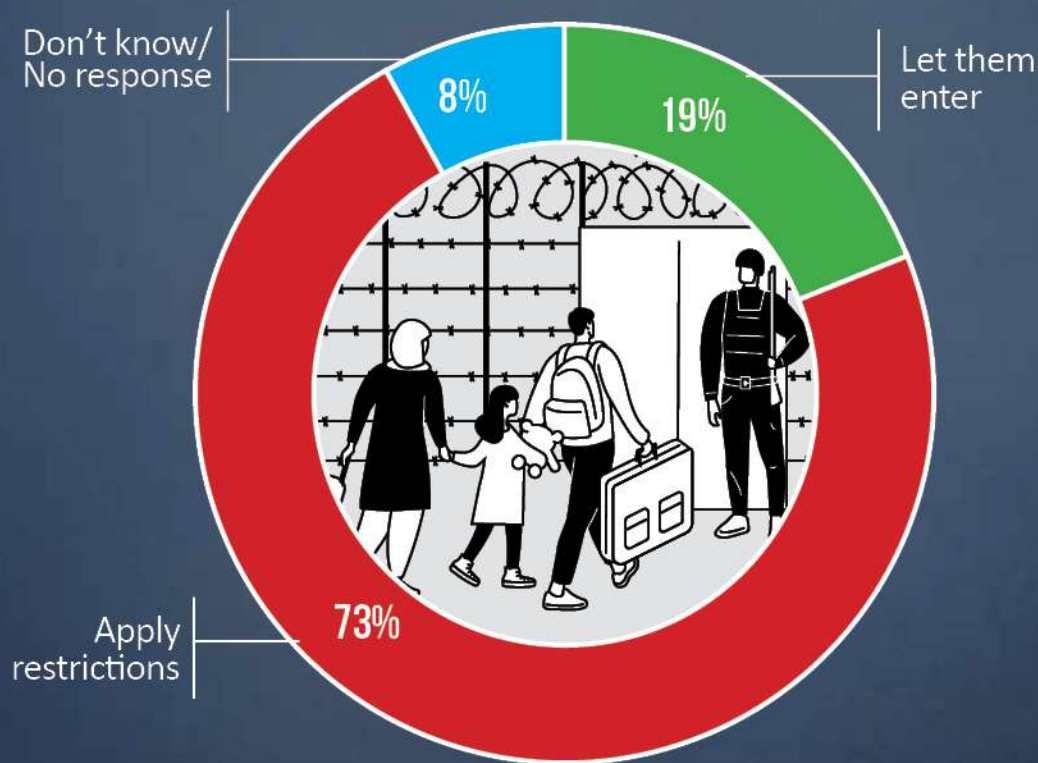

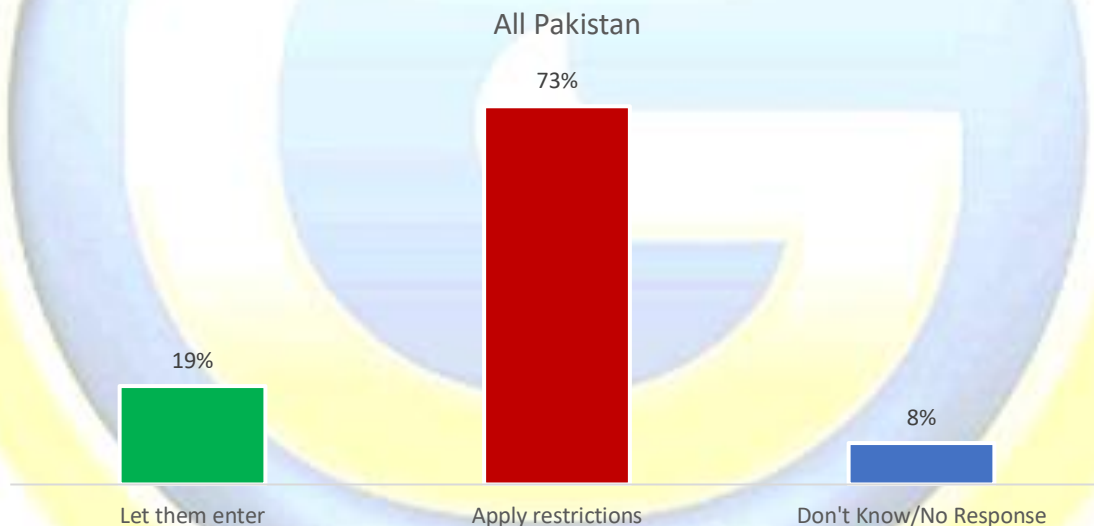
73% of Pakistanis are of the opinion that the Pakistani government should restrict the further entry of Afghan refugees: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), 4th December, 2023

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 73% of Pakistanis are of the opinion that the Pakistani government should restrict the entry of Afghan refugees.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “Some people are of the opinion that the Pakistani government should ban the entry of Afghan refugees. While some are of the opinion that they should be allowed to enter. What do you think?” 19% said ‘let them enter’, 73% said ‘apply restrictions’, and 8% said that they did not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 752 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted during 1st November to 4th November 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 3 -5 percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).

STAT OF THE DAY
