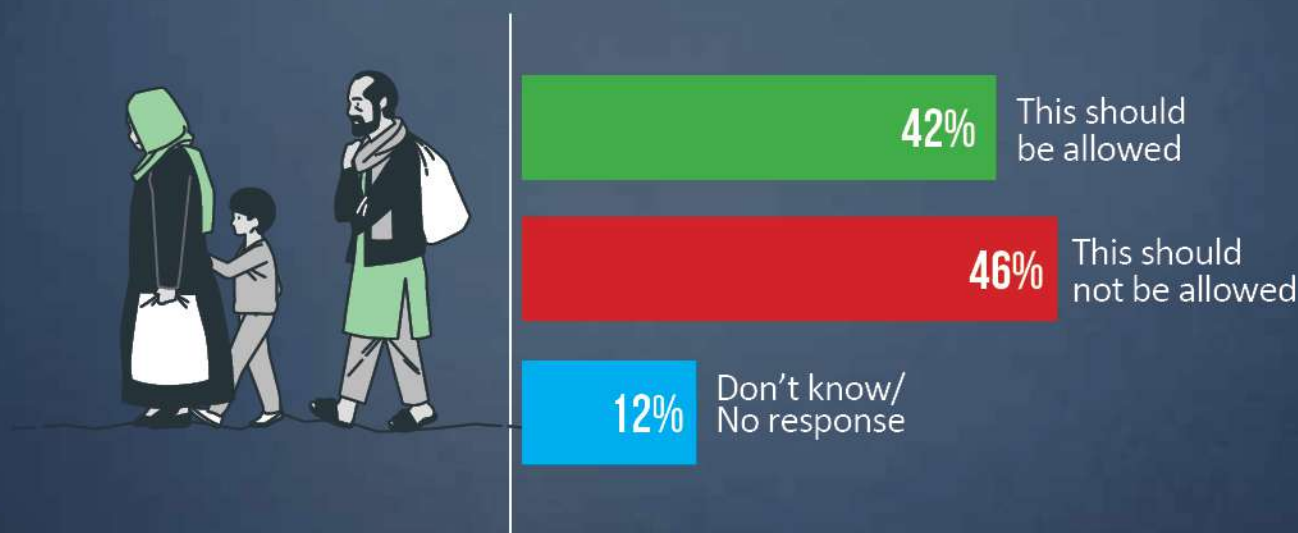

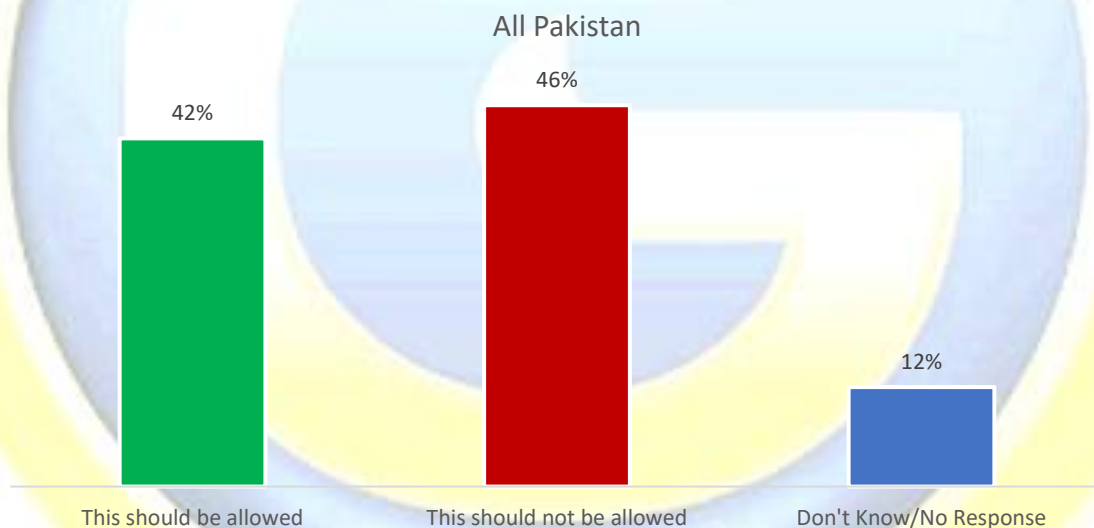

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, Pakistanis were relatively evenly split regarding relief for refugees; 42% believed that those Afghan refugees who request to stay should be allowed to do so while 46% believed in refusing them.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “If some Afghanis request to stay in Pakistan, do you think the government of Pakistan should allowed them to stay?” 42% said ‘this should be allowed’, 46% said ‘this should not be allowed’, and 12% said that they did not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 752 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted during 1st November to 4th November 2023. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 3-5$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
