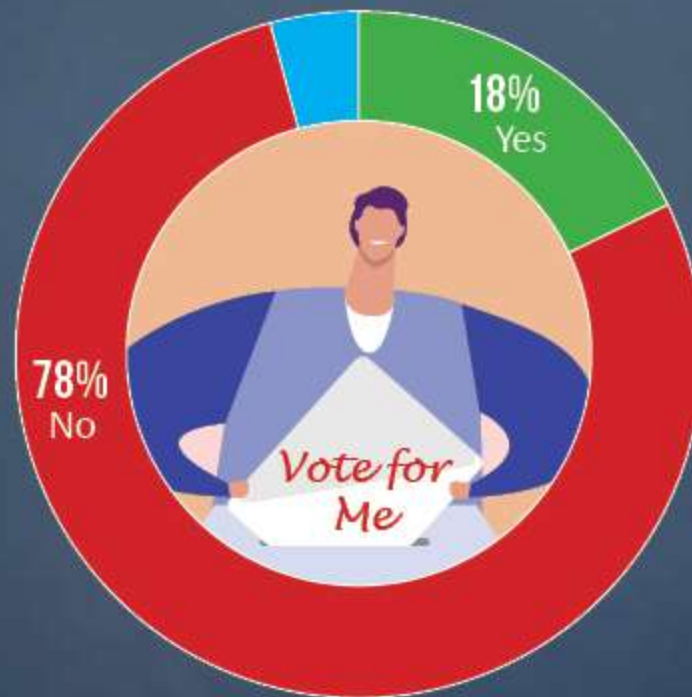

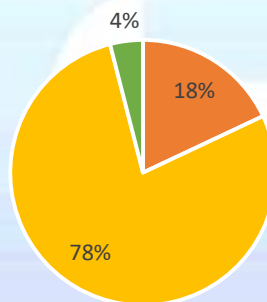

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, only 1 in 5 Pakistanis (18%) report receiving house visits by party candidates, members or workers to ask for votes for their party.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “Please tell if any party candidate/party member or party worker came to your house to ask for vote or to convince you to vote for their party?” In response, 18% said ‘Yes’, 78% said ‘No’, and 4% said that they did not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,015 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from January 3rd – 18th 2024. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
