

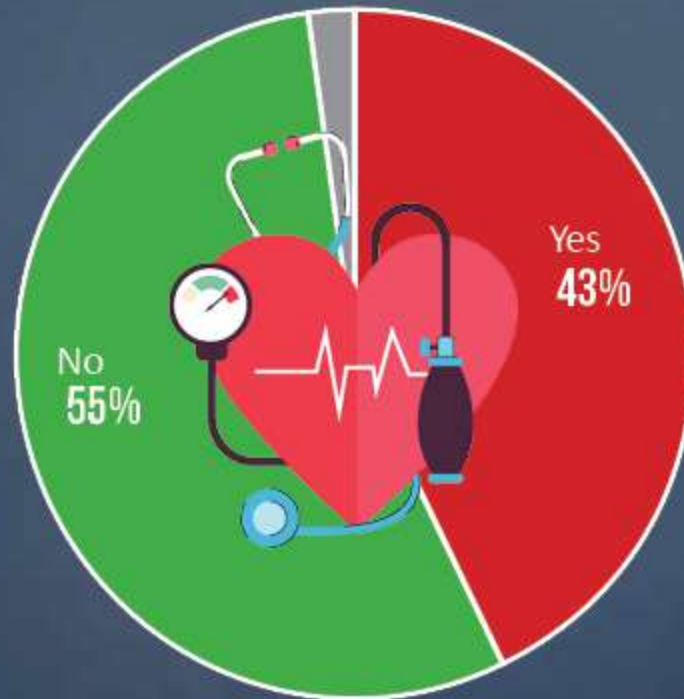

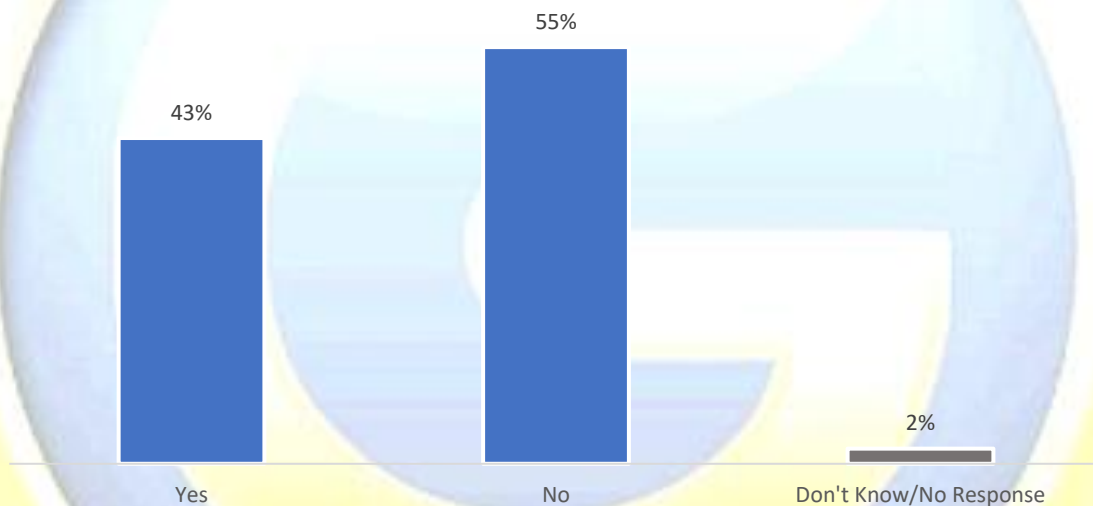
A majority of Pakistanis (55%) report not being worried about their health in the past week, while a sizeable 43% were: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, a majority of Pakistanis (55%) report not being worried about their health in the past week.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “Please indicate whether you have been worried about your health in the past week?” In response, 43% said ‘Yes’, 55% said ‘No’, and 2% said that they did not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,023 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 03rd – 18th January, 2024. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
