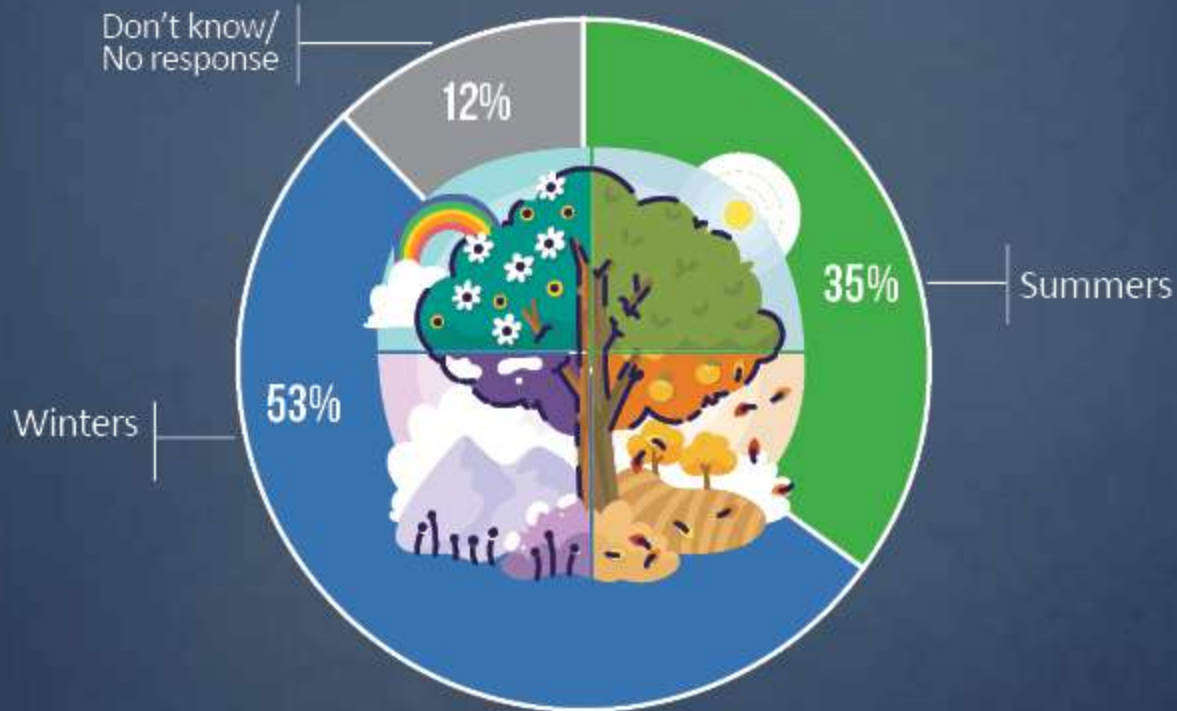

A PROPORTION OF 53% OF PAKISTANIS PREFER WINTER SEASON OVER SUMMER SEASON: GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN

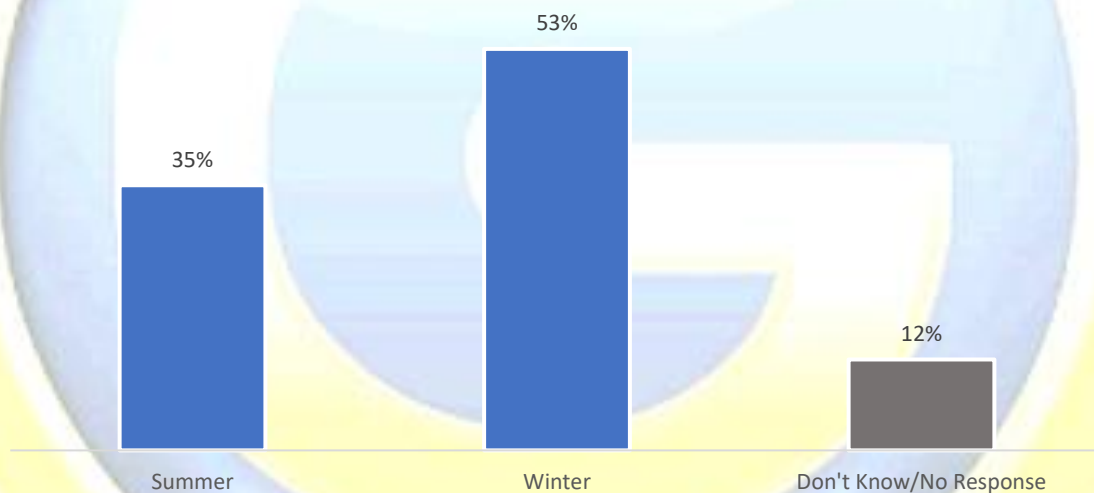
A proportion of 53% of Pakistanis prefer winter season over summer season: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad) 1st February, 2024

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, a proportion of 53% of Pakistanis say that they prefer winter season over summer.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “Some people think that of all the seasons they like summers, while others think they like winters. Which season do you personally like the most out of summer and winter?” In response, 35% said ‘Summer’, 53% said ‘Winter’, and 12% said that they did not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,023 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 03rd – 18th January, 2024. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
