**Even among the 40% Pakistanis who say they have street lights in their neighbourhood, almost a third (32%) report that they never work or work rarely: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan**

*(Islamabad) 19<sup>th</sup> February, 2024*

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, only a proportion of 68% of Pakistanis with street lights in their area of residence report that the street lights work properly.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country who have streetlights in the street of their current place of residence was asked the question, “Please tell whether the street lights in your street are working properly or not?” In response, 68% said ‘Yes, the street lights are working properly’, 23% said ‘Yes, the street lights work properly, but sometimes don’t work’, and 9% said ‘Street lights don’t work at all’.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,023 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 03<sup>rd</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup> January 2024. The error margin is estimated to be approximately  $\pm 2-3$  percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
