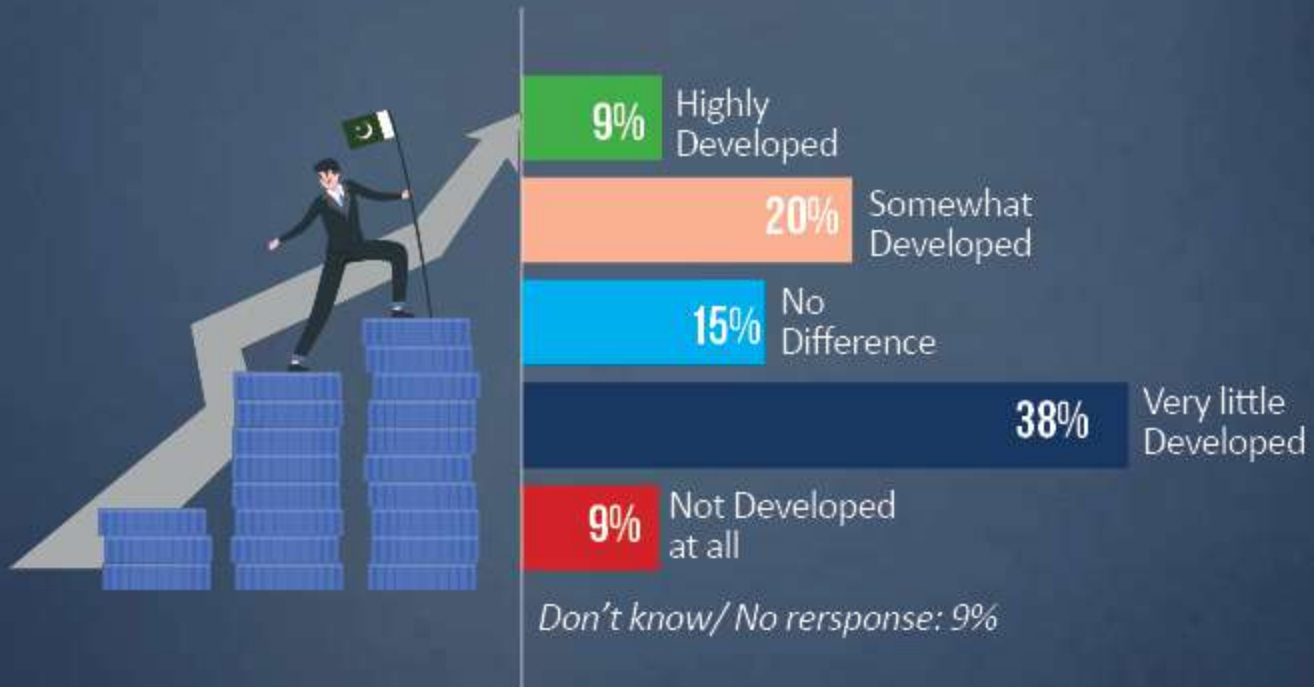

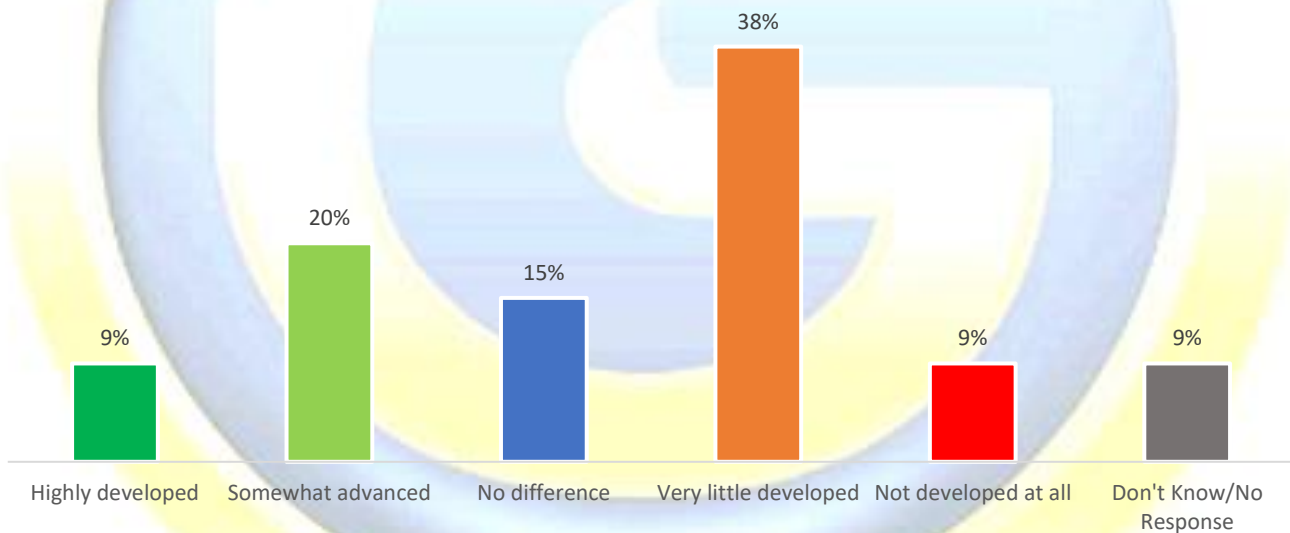
## Nearly half (47%) Pakistanis believe that the economy of Pakistan has developed very little or not at all compared to ten years ago: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad) 21<sup>st</sup> February, 2024

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, nearly half of Pakistanis (47%) believe that the economy of Pakistan has developed very little or not at all compared to ten years ago.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “Overall, do you think Pakistan is economically more developed, less developed or there is no difference now compared to ten years ago?” In response, 9% said ‘Highly developed’, 20% said ‘Somewhat advanced’, 15% said ‘No difference’, 38% said ‘Very little developed’, 9% said ‘Not developed at all’, and 9% said that they did not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,023 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 03<sup>rd</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup> January, 2024. The error margin is estimated to be approximately  $\pm 2-3$  percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
