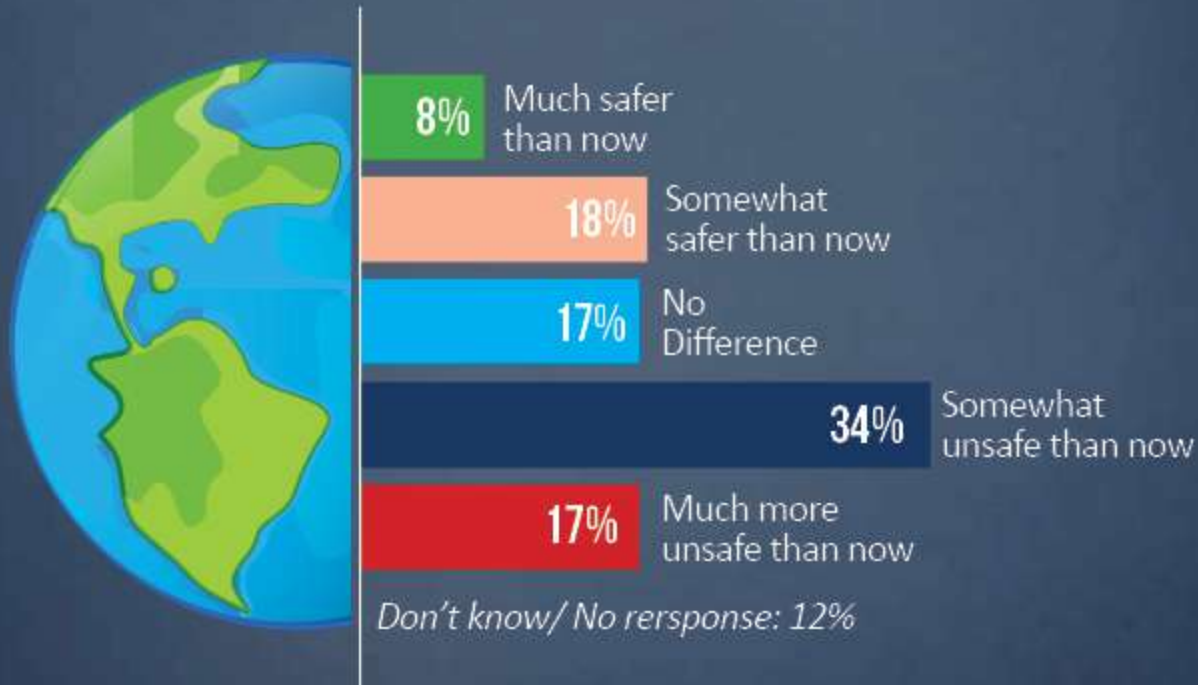

ALMOST HALF (51%) PAKISTANIS BELIEVE THAT THE WORLD FOR THE NEXT GENERATION WILL BE LESS SAFE THAN IT IS NOW: GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN

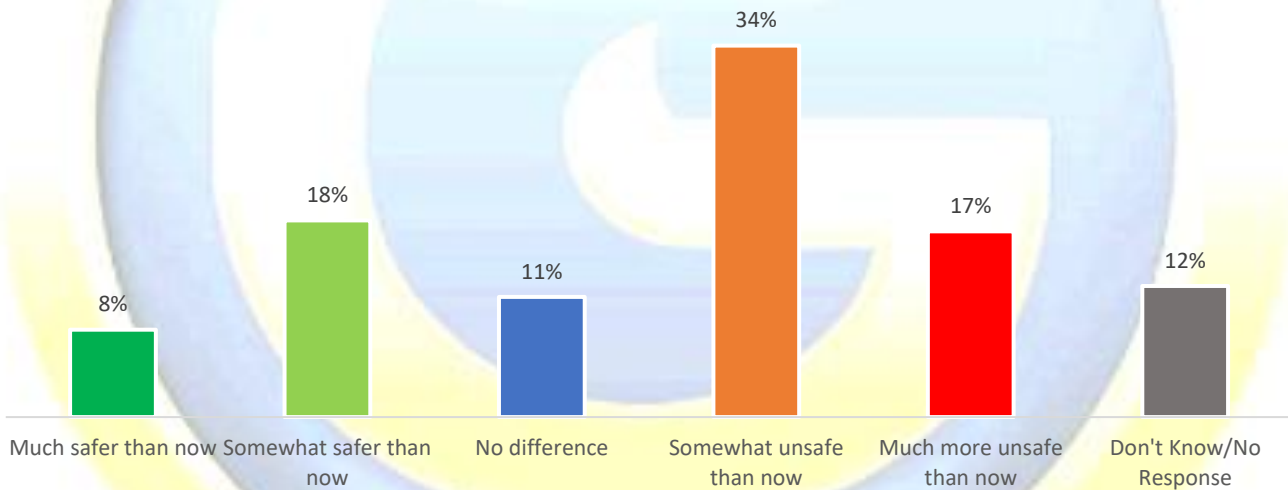
Almost half (51%) Pakistanis believe that the world for the next generation will be less safe than it is now: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad) 23rd February, 2024

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, over half of Pakistanis (51%) believe that the world for the next generation will be less safe than it is now.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the question, “Do you think the world of the next generation will be more safe, less safe or similar to now?” In response, 8% said ‘Much safer than now’, 18% said ‘Somewhat safer than now’, 11% said ‘No difference’, 34% said ‘Somewhat unsafe than now’, 17% said ‘Much more unsafe than now’, and 12% said that they did not know or gave no response.

The study in Pakistan was conducted and released by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,023 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, conducted from 03rd – 18th January, 2024. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic surveys (CATI).
